

GRENE MADE PRESIDENT.

W. H. TEN EYCK FOR CHAIRMAN OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.

ACTION TAKEN AFTER QUIGG RESIGNS FROM UNSELFISH DEVOTION TO THE PARTY—GRUBER SPEAKS.

General Francis Vinton Greene was formally elected president of the Republican County Committee last night after the resignation of Lemuel Ely Quigg had been read and accepted.

The place of chairman of the County Executive Committee was made a separate office, and will probably be filled by W. H. Ten Eyck.

The reading of the resignation was followed by a little mild applause, and then John Sabine Smith, in a short speech eulogistic of Quigg, presented complimentary resolutions, which were passed.

Mr. Smith said he had accurate information that the only reason why Quigg resigned was an unselfish devotion to the good of the party, and was not brought about by any other cause.

I gladly second the nomination because under General Greene the Republican County Committee has been an absolutely harmonious organization.

GREENE ELECTED BY ACCLAMATION.

Mr. Gruber's remarks brought Jastrow Alexander to his feet, who declared sarcastically that his district, the XXVth, did not need to swear allegiance to the new president, as it was loyal to all presidents, and he hoped General Greene would introduce some military discipline into certain Assembly districts where it was badly needed.

Senator Platt slipped away. He had conducted him to the chair, which up to that time had been filled by First Vice-President Hawkes, the meeting applauded him lustily, and General Greene said:

I thank you most deeply for the honor you have conferred upon me. I have had but little experience in political management, but I yield to no one for my respect for the principles of the Republican party, and in order that those principles shall be carried into effect, thorough organization of Republican members is absolutely essential.

I shall not detain you with a long speech, but it seems not out of place that I should refer to a few points upon which I believe the Republican party stands in the proud and noble position of having made the right choice and the right principles, and of having chosen from eight million voters the two men who, by unanimous consent, are presently presiding over the destinies of this country.

The nominations of McKinley and Roosevelt by the National Convention were then heartily endorsed, and the meeting adjourned, but not before adopting several amendments to the constitution, the most important one of which was:

The Executive Committee shall meet for the purpose of organization within five days after the adoption of this amendment, and thereafter within ten days after its appointment by the call of the president of the County Committee, and shall forthwith elect its chairman, who shall be ex officio a member of the Executive Committee and the Committee on Election Officers.

This provides for a new chairman of the Executive Committee, which position was formerly held by Mr. Quigg, ex officio. W. H. Ten Eyck is slated for it.

MONDAY BEGINS STATE CAMPAIGN.

ODELL PREPARES TO PUSH THE WORK AFTER THOROUGH ORGANIZATION.

Hannibal, Mo., July 5.—The special train carrying Governor Theodore Roosevelt from the Rough Riders' reunion arrived at Hannibal early today. A large crowd greeted the Governor, and close attention was given to his brief address. It was, in part, as follows:

I wish I could have spoken here on the Fourth of July, but I shall say what I would have said had it been yesterday. I am a great thing for a Nation to have great memories of the foundation stones upon which we build. But we must have more than that. That was my great wish, because it did not have to be.

I always wished on the Fourth of July, besides reading the Declaration of Independence, to read at least the Preamble to the Constitution. We must have that as the cornerstone of the temple of our liberties, lest it degenerate into license and then into anarchy.

Quincy, Ill., July 5.—Governor Roosevelt arrived in Quincy at 9:10 a. m. The Governor and his party were at once driven to the Newcomb Hotel, where a reception was held. A procession followed through the principal streets. Afterward the Governor was conveyed to the public square, where he delivered an address to an enthusiastic audience of ten thousand people.
