

transit, been very rigorous, but the Immigration Bureau has had for several weeks a special agent actively and successfully at work. He has been through Rumania and other countries from which the exodus of impoverished and degraded classes was setting in, and he has made arrangements which are likely to cause a material decrease in this class of immigration. It is an interesting fact which has escaped public observation that incidentally the action of the United States Government in this matter has led to better and more humane treatment of the Jews in Rumania and other European countries.

One of the most curious boycotts in recent industrial annals has been ordered in Manchester, of all places in the world. Cotton employers have held a representative conference, and with only three dissenting votes have pledged themselves not to purchase any more American spot cotton this month, and these three objectors were only dissatisfied because they considered that the resolution did not go far enough. This action of the cotton spinners is a belated attempt to counteract the effects of their own bad judgment in falling to forecast the rise in prices. Speculators have bought September cotton on a large scale in anticipation of an advance in price, and now that stocks are running out, and there has been a rise of over a penny a pound, spinners who have been buying from hand to mouth are at their mercy, unless they league together and refuse to make any purchases. Many Lancashire mills are now running on half time, and scores will be compelled to stop altogether during the next fortnight. Spinners acting under the advice of the Employers' Federation have decided to thwart the speculators by suspending manufacturing until the next crop begins to come in, during October, or until the dealers who have cornered the market for spot cotton are willing to relax their grip and lower prices. It is a most interesting struggle.

The British Association has opened its yearly session at Bradford with a large attendance of English and Scotch members, but with only a small cluster of foreign visitors and three or four Americans. Sir William Turner's presidential address on "Mysteries of Cell-plasm and the Origins of Life" was one of the most noteworthy scientific papers of recent years. One sentence in it will probably become a familiar quotation, namely: "We know not as regards time when the first went forth, 'Let there be life,' and there was life." The president of the geographical section was enabled to pay a tribute to the Duke of Abruzzi, whose brilliant Arctic work is a theme for enthusiastic leaders in the London journals to-day. Mrs. Ayton and other Scotch and English women of science have not labored in vain. The conservative British Association has at last passed a resolution authorizing women to serve as members of the general and sectional committees.

The rush of American tourists homeward still continues with unabated volume. The New-York carried a full list of passengers to-day, and the Liverpool steamers are equally crowded. The booking for September was never heavier in transatlantic trade. Passenger traffic on the Continent has been almost unprecedented, notwithstanding the fact that English tourists in the main have stayed at home this summer. Their places have been taken by Americans and Germans, especially in Switzerland and Northern Italy. Munich and the Tyrol have never had so many visitors before, and the Engadine has been crowded all the way from Landeck and Schmitz to St. Moritz and Maloja. There has also been a great rush of visitors to Zermatt and Chamounix, and Interlaken and Lucerne have been crowded. Diligence routes in mountain passes like the Simplon and Furca have received less patronage. This has been due to the absence of English tourists and mountain climbers.

The publishing trade is overwhelmed with business here, and the supply of books for the autumn promises to be unusually large. There will be something to read in addition to war books, which have fallen flat during the last twelve months. The theatrical season is opening quietly, with "Julius Caesar" at Her Majesty's, Miss Julia Nelson as "Sweet Nell" at the Haymarket, Miss Marie Tempel as "English Nell" at the Prince of Wales's, Mr. George Alexander in Mr. Sydney Grundy's "A Debt of Honor" at the St. James's, and Mr. Charles Hawtrey in "A Message from Mars," which promises to last until Christmas. Mr. Sydney Grundy and Mrs. W. K. Clifford have started an amiable controversy over the dramatic evidences involved in the resemblance of plays written by them, which recalls a similar controversy between Mr. A. W. Pinero and Mr. Thomas Hardy over "The Squire" and "Far from the Madding Crowd." Plagiarism is always an attractive but seldom a convincing theme. I. N. F.

PARIS.

A FRACTION AGAINST THE RUSSIAN ALLIANCE.

DISAFFECTION WITH THE NEW MUSCOVITE TARIFF—A TOLBANT SPIRIT TOWARD GERMANY—THE WOMEN'S CONGRESS.

Paris, Sept. 8.—The disappointment caused by the czar's decision not to visit the Paris Exposition has not been confined to the mission of M. de Wit, the Russian Finance Minister, and in the St. Andrew crowd conferred upon President Loubet, M. Camille Pelletan, a Radical Deputy from Marseilles, who, together with M. Yves Guyot and an influential group of advanced Liberals, regards the Franco-Russian alliance as a mockery wherein all the advantage is on the side of Russia, has profited by the present phase of popular lukewarmness toward Russia to publish some facts concerning the new Russian tariff which attract wide attention. M. Pelletan points out that the duties on French products established by the czar's ukase, recently issued, are ruinous to French commerce, for the increase in duties varies from 20 to 50 per cent, and in some cases becomes practically prohibitive. Russia consumes annually 4,000,000 litres of French wine; the new ukase raises the duty from one franc a litre to one franc and a half. French wearing apparel—wool, silk, linen, shoes—is subjected to a 30 per cent increase of duty at the Russian frontier. M. Pelletan complains that there are too many dowers and fireworks in the relations between the Quai d'Orsay and the Nevsky Prospect, and suggests that a sprightly vaudeville entitled "Les Surprises de l'Alliance Russe" would just now have as marked a success as did "Les Surprises du Divorce."

In diplomatic circles the outlook in China is considered more hopeful. The propositions from Washington are regarded as supplying a basis for an understanding among the Powers. It is felt here that never before has American diplomacy been exerted with such weight and prestige in the world's affairs as at present. The opinion here is that Emperor William is determined to act alone and upon his own responsibility in regard to maintaining a large German force at Peking, and that, in view of the fact that Germany has a greater right to average than any other country—for Baron von Kettler was the only foreign Minister murdered by the Chinese—Russia and the other Powers will agree to concede to the Emperor the satisfaction of having Count von Waldersee at the head of an imposing German army corps make a solemn entry into Peking with due Wagnerian pomp and ceremonial. "Figaro" to-day, taking its cue from the Quai d'Orsay, states that

such a requirement on the part of the Kaiser would be fully justified, because the assassination of his personal representative places Germany in a different position from other Powers, and that, moreover, such a requirement is not incompatible with the evacuation of the Chinese capital by the troops of other nations. The opinion generally expressed here is that it will soon be found that Germany will impose upon China a crushing pecuniary indemnity, with a territorial guarantee for its payment.

The number of visitors to the Exposition is steadily increasing, the average number of paying entrances for the last five days being 270,000. Of these at least two-thirds were women. The International Congress of Women, which is now holding its sessions from 9 o'clock in the morning until 5 in the afternoon, is an unprecedented success. The vast hall of the Congress rustles with silk and is fragrant with the aroma of new-mown hay and mignonette. It is no fatality to say that the majority of the two thousand female delegates are attractive in appearance, fashionably gowned and wear the daintiest summer hats. The sessions are ably presided over by Mme. Maria Pogon, president of the French League for Women's Rights; and the general secretary, Mme. Marguerite Durand, Editor of the "Fronde," wearing a charming pale blue and straw colored corsage, a point lace tie and white kid gloves, ably assists her chief. The daily record of the debates and resolutions fills nine closely printed columns in the "Fronde." It is gratifying to announce that after a very animated discussion the Congress has finally repudiated the motion for "Union Libre." Resolutions were passed with a view of securing absolute equality in marriage rights and obligations, absolute freedom from parental tyranny, absolute freedom for girls over twenty to read whatever books they please and to frequent whatever theatres or music halls they may prefer.

Further resolutions declare that all girls, whether rich or poor, should be compelled by law to adopt some profession, calling or trade, and make themselves proficient in it, no matter whether they should eventually practice it or not. This serious mass of women seated on hard wooden benches unprovided with backs, taking notes, preparing interpellations, making speeches, occasionally being called to order by the presidential bell, all in strict accordance with parliamentary procedure, is certainly one of the most remarkable sights yet presented at the World's Fair.

A thorough and impartial investigation shows the average age of the delegates to be thirty; only a very few have white hair; maybe two dozen are scarcely out of their teens, and several of them have peculiarly earnest, thoughtful, pleasing faces, resembling the statues of Hypatia. Yesterday evening Mme. Marguerite Durand gave a charming reception and fete to her fellow-delegates in the "Fronde" Building, and a theatrical performance followed, in which all the actors were women, the Theatre Francais being ably represented by Mme. Amel and Mlle. Dumnil.

The theatrical novelty of the week, produced in honor of the Women's Congress, is a clever little review of the Exposition, entitled "I y a de la Femme," by Victor de Cottens and Adrien Vely, which is making a hit at the Parisiana Music Hall. It contains burlesques of Sarah Bernhardt and Coquelin, parodies of Charpentier's opera "Louise," and satirical take-offs on the leading features of the World's Fair, prominent among which are the procession, dance and chorus of the international restaurants, each being represented by young actresses, one of whom, travestied as a Manhattan cocktail, personifies the remedy to quench a travelling American's thirst.

The beautiful and cool, but sunny, weather continues to attract Americans from Switzerland and the other summer resorts. Mr. and Mrs. Marshall Field, jr., are making a brief visit here. Mr. and Mrs. E. Rollins Morse have arrived from a tour through the Engadine. Mrs. W. K. Nixon, of Chicago, who has returned from a visit to the Duke and Duchess of Newcastle, is staying with Mr. and Mrs. W. Whitcombe Cotton in the Avenue Marceau. Numerous dinners are given daily at the Exposition, at the fashionable hotels, at the restaurants in the Boulevard, or in the Bois de Boulogne. On Thursday Mr. William T. Dannatt entertained Mr. and Mrs. Stanford White at dinner. Mr. Louis Stern, one of the American Commissioners, gives a dinner to-night at the Ambassadeurs Restaurant, in the Champs Elysees, to his fellow-commissioners and friends. Mr. Charles Richard Dodge, Director of Agriculture on the United States Commission, has gone to Switzerland for a two weeks' holiday. Mr. Robert J. Thompson, secretary of the Lafayette Monument Association, his wife and son, have returned to Paris after a two months' visit in Germany. Archbishop Ireland is also back in Paris again. The American colony put in a solid appearance this afternoon at the garden party given in the Exposition grounds by a combination of the Ceylon, Canada, Australia and British India sections, cleverly organized by Mr. R. V. Webster, the Ceylon Commissioner; a feature of the entertainment was a series of dances in tents or booths of each of the terpelichorean quartets of the World's Fair.

Manchesters, Sept. 8.—Thirty Lancashire cotton mills have already closed. "The Manchester Guardian" explains that a great part of the little cotton at Liverpool is believed to be of inferior quality, and prices are too high to make spinning profitable with yarn and cloth at their present values. "New-York and Manchester," the paper continues, "are engaged in a game of pull, and the resolution of the spinners is Manchester's answer to the czar's ukase. At New-York, in the interests of the Lancashire industry, we may hope it will still further discourage the bulls and speedily cheapen cotton."

Manchesters, Sept. 8.—The coal question continues prominent. Henry Labouchere, in "Truth," noting the discussion of the imports of coal from the United States, says: "I was talking a day or two ago with a large import and export merchant in Italy, whose firm owns six ships. He told me that he had been getting steam coal from America both by rail and by sea, and that he had just as good as English steam coal at a considerable saving. Whether it will ever be cheaper in England depends upon the American coal-mining prices, which, he believes, they will do, as he has studied American coal pits on the spot, his opinion, as a practical man, is worth recording."

The coming elections.—The week has been prolific of discussion, but, though the main questions of international and national interest appear to be settling, the most serious factor of international politics remains to be approached. A solution, they have not yet reached, and finally which Great Britain so earnestly desires in order that she may attend to her private concerns. Among the latter stand out most prominently the South African question and the general election. By help of the desire for peace dominating all the minds of the British people, an achievement without hindrance the formal peace of the South African republics, which a cabinet Minister declared last year would be an "unmitigated misfortune." Lord Roberts's proclamation, however, has not advanced matters much. The Jingoes pretend that the annexation of the Transvaal is tantamount to the end of the South African war, but the Boer view of the country differs, and as a matter of fact there are no signs that the British are masters of the country anywhere except in the case of strips of land along the railroads. However, in spite of the delay, the scheme for an early appeal to the voters. Everything appears to be shaping for an October election, and the possibility of a general election during the coming week will probably be speedily followed by a definite pronouncement of the date of the election, as well as British views on the Far Eastern matters.

Among the interesting features of the election here is the movement of the Liberal Unionists to return to the Liberal fold, and to be again what Sir William Vernon Harcourt described in 1885 as the "middle party of England," a Liberal without any adjectives.

A candidate for the House of Commons, a Liberal, has been adopted as the Liberal champion for Patrick Burghs.

FROM SKIBO CASTLE.—Charles S. Smith, of New-York, who is returning to the United States this week after an extensive tour of Europe, has just completed a fortnight's visit to Skibo Castle,

the Scotch estate of Andrew Carnegie. Mr. Smith said: "Mr. Carnegie is going to have one of the finest castles in Scotland when the repairs are complete. He has had his house built on a hillside, and grounds all summer, doing works in transforming the estate. I played golf nearly every day with Mr. Carnegie, and know that the stories of dissipation in the Carnegie family are untrue. I saw Mr. Carnegie's wife, Mrs. Schwebel, in Europe, but he was not at Skibo Castle. From my own knowledge, I can say that there is no more commercial outlook in the United States. He is going to the United States in October."

IMPROVIDENT AMERICANS.—"I never knew so many improvident Americans in London," said United States Vice-consul Westcott to a representative of the Associated Press, "at the time of the year you are sure to find many who have overtaxed their financial resources. But the applications for relief here outnumber anything in the history of the Consulate. Of course, there are no means in our hands to finance stranded travellers, and thus long lines of the poor are to be seen. Expensive guests at the leading hotels say they cannot go into the streets without being besieged for financial aid by impoverished compatriots."

KANSAS CITY FIREMEN.—The visiting members of the Kansas City fire brigade are entertaining crowds at the Crystal Palace. The smartness of the American firemen has called forth unstinted praise from the London newspapers.

AMERICAN METHODS PRAISED.—The report of the British commercial agent at Chicago, printed conspicuously in "The Times," attracts attention as a further evidence of the skill and progress of American mechanics. The report extols American methods, the use of labor saving machinery and the rapidity and excellence of their product.

THEATRICALS.—The Kendalls, who have been busily rehearsing a new play by Mrs. W. K. Clifford, entitled "Unwily but Too Well," have been charged by the discovery that Sydney Grundy's play, "A Debt of Honor," produced by George Alexander on Thursday at the St. James's Theatre, is a replica of the work they had in hand. Mr. Clifford's play was printed in the March issue of Lady Randolph Churchill's "Anglo-Saxon Review," and under the title, "Likeness of the Night," and was twice read and rejected by Alexander. As a result, a heated newspaper controversy is in progress. Grundy partly declares he never knew of the existence of the work they had in hand. That Alexander had no idea what he Grundy was writing till the play was completed, Grundy adds. He did not know until the "Anglo-Saxon Review" had published it in "The Anglo-Saxon Review," nor have I met anybody who did."

Novelties in theatrical circles are scarce and few are invited to-day and to-morrow. Henry Dupe, manager of Keith's new theatre in London, returned to-day with a new play, much satisfied with the progress he has made here.

PARIS NEWS AND COMMENT.

FRENCH STATESMEN PUZZLED.—France is in a dilemma. Russian proposition to withdraw from Peking has resolved itself into a problem for her which French statesmen are now tackling very gingerly. The complete withdrawal from Peking, after careful consideration, is now deemed not to be altogether in line with France's interests and her views as to the best and most effective method of dealing with the Empress Dowager and her clique of advisers. France is now forced to choose between the course of the withdrawal from Peking and the policy dictated to her by the Russian alliance, and French statesmen have been devoted for the last week to an endeavor to splice these two conflicting policies into a compromise which will not jeopardize her friendship with Russia and at the same time will not prejudice her own position in China. The suggestion, therefore, that while the bulk of the troops be withdrawn from Peking a small international force be still retained in the city comes as a peculiarly acceptable idea to France. Russia and Germany appear to be the only serious stumbling blocks in the way of a general acceptance of this compromise, the first named desiring the total withdrawal of the allied forces, and the latter wishing a continued occupation.

Should the proposal fall through and Russia and America withdraw all their troops, France would undoubtedly follow suit. It would be too rude a salute to the Russian alliance to refuse to do so. To abandon her ally and remain in Peking with, as her associates, the British, the French, the German and the Japanese, would be a very serious matter, and one which would be very widely discussed among the people here.

MAROLLES'S REPORTS.—An eye opener as to the lack of accord between the various military commanders in China is furnished by the report of Captain Marolles, who commanded the French contingent up to the time of the capture of Tien-Tsin. Captain Marolles relates each day's events in the form of a diary, in which appear statements which a Paris paper describes as tantamount to a masked indictment of the Russian General Siesel, who, while he has obtained a soldier's promotion, it says, wished to win or even to be beaten alone. The result of this ambition was the loss of hundreds of lives. Marolles, under date of June 27, writes: "Russians attacked the East Arsenal at Tien-Tsin without notifying any one, but eventually the German contingent took place. Mr. Marolles did not operate, which was not agreeable to them. It is apparent that there is no accord between the military chiefs."

Two days later Marolles writes: "The Russians made a reconnaissance on the left bank, without notifying any one. When the daylight began and the town suffered an hour's bombardment, the next day the Russian contingent was ordered to evacuate the town. The next day is dated July 4, and reads: "The Russians evacuated the railroad depot at 7:30 o'clock this morning. As the post is absolutely deserted, the evacuation would compel the British, the English, the Japanese, the French, the German and the Italian contingents to evacuate the depot. Marolles's report thus shows that there was no accord, even between the French and Russians."

ANGLO-FRENCH ACCORD.—The letter of Admiral Seymour to the French commandant, outlining the splendid conduct of the French contingent of his Peking relief force, has created a most pleasant impression here, and has proved of much greater value in improving the Anglo-French relations than he could possibly have anticipated. It is said that the French commandant, who bore the fruit this week of the visit of the British Chamber of Commerce to Paris. The warmth of their reception was noteworthy. There were many prominent men among the delegates, and at a banquet in Paris, at which M. Millerand, Minister of Commerce, was the guest of honor, an Anglo-French accord was the subject of the evening's discussion. The Queen's health and the divers rumors concerning the "Marseillaise." The press comments are most sympathetic.

THE MUSCAT INCIDENT CLOSED.—What was known as the Muscat incident between France and England, arising from the French claim which the Sultan of Muscat, Arabia, is now closed. The Sultan, having made good her claim, and a telegram from Muscat, received on Friday afternoon, announced that the British ultimatum had been handed at the French Consulate.

NATIONALISTS SHUNNED.—The Nationalist Mayor and municipality of Havana received a bad omen this week. Taking advantage of a bad dental banquet offered to all the Mayors of France, they issued invitations to a reception to the Mayors at the Paris Hotel de Ville. Instead of an enthusiastic response, they received quite a number of refusals, including the Mayor of Lyons, the Socialist Mayor of Paris, and the Mayor of Bordeaux, the largest city in France. The latter published his

letter of declination, in which he said openly that he declined to associate himself with the Nationalist municipality of the metropolis.

PERSONAL.—Mrs. Ferdinand Bischoffheim, formerly Miss Mary Payne, is dead. She came from America when a young girl, and figured in the splendid functions of Empress Eugenie, being one of the bridesmaids of the Emperor when married with her. M. Bischoffheim is a Belgian Senator.

CURRENT TOPICS IN BERLIN.

GERMANY AND CHINA.—The number of cable dispatches arriving seriatim imputing to Germany compromise propositions in answer to the Russian-American proposals appear baseless. The correspondent of the Associated Press learns authoritatively that Germany, replying to the advice to withdraw her troops from Peking, has sent Russia detailed reasons why this seems inopportune and calculated to prolong instead of shorten the war. The arguments cited in detail in support of this contention appear identical with the arguments advanced by several other Powers.

The situation in China still continues difficult in a diplomatic sense rather than from a military standpoint. The question of doubtful credentials in the case of Li Hung Chang and other would-be negotiators continues to play an all important role. It is understood that Dr. Mumm von Schwarzenberg, the German Minister to China, reported from Shanghai to the Berlin Office here that he does not believe Li Hung Chang is properly authorized. Judging from repeated information which the Minister received there on the subject.

A Foreign Office official, answering questions, today said: "There are no signs that Russia means to repudiate her proposition, but it is already clear that the estimate of the Powers will not be affected thereby. Germany says Russia is not bound to her proposition, but I am unable to state whether this answer amounts to a rejection. I cannot give an expression on the subject. The Foreign Office knows that the most recent and very contradictory news cables here from Washington is most unpleasant to the United States Government."

The doubt regarding Li Hung Chang's credentials remains. He has not been recognized by the British Government. His peace plenipotentiary, Dr. Mumm von Schwarzenberg, who is still at Shanghai, has not made a visit to Li Hung Chang, nor did the latter visit the British plenipotentiary.
