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STRIKE MAY CONTINUE.

MINERS LIKELY TO REJECT COAL OPERATORS' OFFER.

ARRANGEMENTS COMPLETED FOR THE CONVENTION WHICH OPENS IN SCRANTON TO-DAY.

SIX MORE DEMANDS FRAMED.

REPRESENTATIVES OF BIG COAL COMPANIES SAY THEY WILL NOT BE GRANTED.

Wilkesbarre, Penn., Oct. 11.—The Wilkesbarre assemblies of the United Mine Workers held meetings to-day and instructed the delegates to the Scranton convention to insist on the following demands:

First—Recognition of the union. Second—Power reduced to \$1.00. Third—A 10 per cent advance. Fourth—Two weeks' pay. Fifth—Check docking boss. Sixth—A contract signed by the companies agreeing to the above, to hold good for one year.

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J. F. Giddard, commissioner of the Trunk Line Association, says that the report is incorrect that the official Classification Committee of the association, at its meeting to be held here on October 16, expects to make any advances in rates for the territory under its jurisdiction, the district east of the Mississippi River and north of the Ohio.

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
