DUCE TO REMOVAL OF RESTRICTIONS ON MINING IN AFRICA.

THE LIVERPOOL BANK FRAUDS—AMERICAN PURCHASES OF IRON AND STEEL.

London, Feb. 23, 1 a. m.—The activity in mining stocks remains the leading feature of Stock Exchange speculation. It starts up fresh after every check, and is maintained even when the supply of loanable capital in the open market is small and the discount rates are firm. New small companies are forming, and there is a renewal of activity all along the line. This speculative movement cannot be attributed to the war news, although that is improving, with practical evidence that the burghers are now employed as scouts in the British service and are entrapping their fellow Boers easily. The real secret of the Kaffir boom is the evidence that the British Government intends to remove the disabilities from the mining industry and convert it into a source of wealth which will permit immigration on a large scale. The Farney law, imposing a heavy tax upon the output of gold, is one of the Transvaal statutes repealed by Lord Milner, and other legislative obstacles to the free development of the mining industry have been removed. The capitalist class is satisfied that mining will become vastly more profitable than ever before, and speculators and investors are taking their cues from them.

The prosecuting authorities are receiving more credit than they deserve for their success in obtaining the restitution of a large proportion of the immense sum taken from the Bank of Liverpool by Goudie and the gang of turf gamblers. The work was easy when the forger was arrested, for he made a clean breast of everything, and enabled the prosecution to recover the bulk of the plunder. Goudie was a unique criminal in committing his stupendous series of forgeries and, instead of profiting by them, allowing turf gamblers to rob him systematically. This remarkable case will involve a radical reform in bookkeeping in many English banks.

American buying of English iron and steel on a large scale is reported from the Midlands. The orders are similar to those received in Germany from American, and are explained in the trade as the result of the enormous domestic demand for raw material in the United States.

TOLSTOY AT POINT OF DEATH.

EXCITEMENT AMONG STUDENTS DUE TO NOVELIST'S SERIOUS ILLNESS.

St. Petersburg, Feb. 22.—The latest news received here from Yalta (Crimea) is to the effect that Count Tolstoy is at the point of death.

Berlin, Feb. 22.—Advices received here from St. Petersburg attribute the excitement among the students partially to a false report, which was spread on February 20, of Count Tolstoy's death. It was asserted that the authorities had suppressed the news because the Holy Synod has decided whether to proceed with the annual communication of the author. Several hundred students attempted to invade the Isaac Cathedral in order to have mass prayers for the repose of Count Tolstoy's soul. "Long live the immortal Tolstoy, Russia's greatest man! Down with the dogs!" The police charged and dispersed the demonstrators. The universities of Kiev and Kharkoff are closed. At the latter place the police came into collision with students and workmen.

MORE TROOPS FOR THE ISTHMUS.

COLOMBIAN GOVERNMENT ANXIOUS TO SUPPRESS THE REVOLUTION.

Panama, Feb. 22.—At a meeting of prominent Conservatives held at the Governor's Palace yesterday afternoon, a committee of five was appointed to consider the question of resources and the advisability of purchasing another steamer. This committee later made a favorable report. Governor Arjona showed a telegram he had received from Bogota, announcing that three thousand men were ready to embark at Barranquilla for the isthmus, and were only awaiting transportation, and that two thousand men had left Santander for the isthmus. This is taken to show the eagerness of the government to end the revolution.

DEMARK TO CEDE ISLANDS SOON.

A BILL TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE RIGSDAG NEXT WEEK.

Copenhagen, Feb. 22.—The text of the treaty between the United States and Denmark, for the sale of the Danish West Indies, was distributed this afternoon, in Danish and English, to the members of the Rigsdag. A bill dealing with the sale of the islands will probably be submitted to the Rigsdag at the end of next week. King Christian said, yesterday, at a Cabinet council, that he hoped the matter would be settled as soon as possible.

AN AMERICAN BARK IN FLAMES.

Captain Pearce, of the steamer Karamania, which arrived here yesterday from the West Indies, reported that on the night of February 1, in latitude 36.4, longitude 80.45, she passed an American bark in flames from stem to stern. The vessel apparently was oil laden, as burning oil was floating on the water. The Karamania stood by until daylight, but could see no signs of life or boats on her. The name was not visible, as it had been burned away. The vessel reported by the St. Helena is evidently the vessel reported by the St. Helena on her arrival at Antwerp on February 15. Captain Owen, of the St. Helena, reported that on the night of February 1, in latitude 37, longitude 81, she passed an abandoned vessel in flames.

A NATIONAL CHRYSANTHEMUM SHOW.

Indianapolis, Feb. 22.—The Chrysanthemum Society of America, at a special meeting held here on the call of the president, A. Herrington, of Madison, N. J., decided to give a national chrysanthemum show in Chicago next November, in connection with the annual flower show of the Chicago Horticultural Society. This will be the first national chrysanthemum show ever held in the United States, and the show is expected to have a large display. The president stated that florists of the United States and England will offer prizes at the show for the best display of chrysanthemums originated in those countries.

theatre were not conducted on these lines. Prince Henry would not have honored me as he did. When I announced that I would produce for the entertainment of our guest "Im Weissen Rössel," some of my good friends objected. "All the year," they said, "he preaches about classics and, once, when a prince comes, he gives us a farce. Well, for a few hours Prince Henry was to be my guest, and knowing that a host's first duty is to entertain his guest, I felt no conscientious scruples on account of the selection of the play. I knew that the Prince needed no education at my hands. But to satisfy all, I have concluded to change the play for a railroad station in an American town, which programme may be carried out when the Prince does come, as I hope he will, before he leaves our shores.

Mr. Conried explained the following arrangement for the audience to get all that is paid for, and to pay for no more than it got: If, as Mr. Conried still hopes, the Prince is able to come to the theatre on another night, the members of last night's audience may bring their coupons to the box office and receive tickets for the same seats for the new performance, by paying the price of a regular performance. Mr. Conried told a Tribune reporter that even when his advanced prices the performance was costing him more than the receipts, and that, even considering the refunding of a part of the admission money, it would cost him more than he received. He said that for him not to come, because in the former case it would be necessary to renew all the floral decorations, which is far the larger part of the whole. Mr. Conried's desire that the Prince shall come is wholly for the honor and pleasure of welcoming him to his theatre and for the glory of his house.

FINAL LANDING PREPARATIONS.

THE HOHENZOLLERN IN THE PINK OF CONDITION AND BEDECKED WITH FLAGS.

The final preparations for the landing of Prince Henry were completed yesterday forenoon. The pier was a busy scene while these preparations were going on.

Aboard the imperial yacht everything was bustle. Rods and woodwork were being polished and scrubbed, and the work of adorning the stairs and standing rigging was occupying the attention of the jacksies. At the fore a big German flag was being hoisted, and the Stars and Stripes on the main truck. Strung between the masts the flags of the international code were flying forward, and the imperial code aft. The ganplanks were draped in bunting.

PASSED CLOSE TO THE LUCANIA.

THE KRONPRINZ WAS ONLY TWO MILES AWAY WHEN SHE MET THE CUNARDER.

Liverpool, Feb. 22.—The Cunard line steamer Lucania has arrived here. It was on February 19 at 11.05 a. m., in latitude 45.59 north, longitude 25.16 west, that she communicated with the North German Lloyd steamer Kronprinz Wilhelm. The Kronprinz Wilhelm passed two miles to the southward of the Lucania.

MAYORS EXCHANGE GREETINGS.

Mayor Low yesterday received a cable dispatch from the Mayor of Berlin, Germany. It was as follows: On this day when New-York greets the brother of the Kaiser as its guest, we cordially express our joy over the close friendship of America and Germany, and our hopes of its continuance and strengthening. MR. CLEVELAND NOT TO ATTEND.

Washington, Feb. 22.—President Grover Cleveland has declined the invitation of President Roosevelt to attend the dinner at the White House in honor of Prince Henry, assigning ill health as a reason.

LAUNCHING GUESTS MUST BE ON TIME.

Wallace Downey, of the shipbuilding firm of Townsend & Downey, who are building the German Kaiser's new yacht Meteor, announced yesterday that the guests invited to witness the launching of the yacht on next Tuesday at Shooters Island must be on hand promptly on Tuesday morning if they desired to witness the ceremony. Mr. Downey said the guests would be transported to Shooters Island by a special boat that will leave the Staten Island ferry slip, Whitehall-st., at 8.30 o'clock for the shipyard. After the launching the same boat will transport the guests back to the city, leaving the pier about 1.30 in the afternoon.

THE KAISER KEPT INFORMED.

NOT DISTURBED OVER DELAY IN PRINCE HENRY'S ARRIVAL AT THIS PORT.

Berlin, Feb. 22.—No concern is felt at the palace on account of the non-arrival of the steamer Kronprinz Wilhelm at New-York on schedule time. The Emperor, who has been having his last day's hunting at Hubertusstuck, returned here this evening at 7 o'clock. His majesty was advised, by wire, at Eberswalde station, the nearest telegraphic point to his hunting lodge, of the severe weather prevailing on the Atlantic, and of the probable delay in the Kronprinz Wilhelm's arrival at her destination. The court officials and the evening papers expressed regret at the derangement of the plans that seemed imminent.
