It has in *no* way retarded or injured the resort. Already new buildings are in the course of construction on the small burned area. The famous Boardwalk is again intact, the short section that was destroyed being rebuilt in forty-eight hours. The hotels and boarding houses destroyed only represented a capacity of 1,500 guests, while the total capacity of Atlantic City's hotels is over 175,000 people. This demonstrates the real insignificance of the fire from the standpoint of interfering with business.
