

CAPT. HERLIHY ON TRIAL.

JAMES B. REYNOLDS DENIES ON CROSS-EXAMINATION THAT HE WAS EXPELLED AS SCHOOL TRUSTEE.

The opening session of the trial of Captain John D. Herlihy for neglect of duty while commander in the Edridge-st. station, better known as the "Red Light" district, which began yesterday, was marked by sharp legal skirmishes between Assistant District Attorney Rand and Messrs. Elkus and House, Captain Herlihy's counsel. James B. Reynolds, Mayor Low's secretary, was attacked in cross-examination.

The proceedings were opened by Mr. Rand, who said in part: Captain Herlihy is not charged with accepting money for the protection of disorderly houses, nor is he charged with being in the business of turning disorderly houses. He is not charged with participating in the maintenance of disorderly houses, but simply with a misdemeanor in failing to suppress them. An officer who thus fails in his duty is guilty of a misdemeanor.

We charge not that these houses existed in spite of his efforts to suppress them, but that through his willful neglect to suppress them, and through his wife's influence, he was engaged and employed by citizens to suppress these places. It was stated that his superiors at such places existed, giving street and number, yet for some reason best known to himself he allowed them to exist.

Mr. Rand read various police regulations, laying stress on the rule requiring the captains to report in duplicate every Monday all houses suspected of being disorderly; also the one about the preservation of peace and the prevention of crime.

Julius C. Peterson testified that as a messenger in the Police Department he, on September 25, 1899, had carried a report by Captain Herlihy to Commissioner York, in which Herlihy had reported that there were no disorderly houses in his precinct. On January 8, 1900, the captain again had reported "No disorderly places in this precinct."

The reports covering the entire period of Captain Herlihy's stay in the precinct were similar, the sole difference being that occasionally a house was marked "suspected."

James B. Reynolds was the only witness who testified at the afternoon session. Mr. Rand questioned him about conditions at No. 25 Livingston-st. Mr. Reynolds told of having been solicited in front of this place by women. He said that he had seen men and women entering the house, and on one occasion a boy had attempted to pull him into the place.

Mr. Reynolds testified that the house was known as disorderly, and said the same about No. 31 Livingston and No. 49 Delancey sts. Mr. Reynolds said that he had met Captain Herlihy, and when he had made complaints about the condition of the district that official had said that he had no sympathy with "uptown reformers."

Mr. Reynolds' reply that he wanted to get an opportunity for respectable people to be spoken in public, Captain Herlihy had answered that the women had to live somewhere.

The witness was asked in cross-examination as to alleged charges he had preferred against a school teacher while he was a school trustee. He replied: "I said in public meeting that I knew of a teacher who didn't know how to spell."

Q—Were you summoned to appear before the Board of Education in regard to this matter? A— I was.

Q—Did you refuse to testify? A— I did.

Q—Was it a matter of which you were expelled by the Board of Education? A— Yes.

Mr. Reynolds' face flushed. "I was not," he said.

Q—I show you a resolution of the Board of Education expelling you. Does that refresh your memory? A— It does not.

Mr. Rand interrupted, and asked if Mr. Reynolds had not refused to testify before the Board of Education the teacher's name whom he had spoken in a public address, and he said he had refused.

The case was then adjourned until 10:30 a. m. Monday.

WANT HEINZE ENJOINED AGAIN.

AMALGAMATED AND BOSTON AND MONTANA SAY HIS MEN HAVE BLOWN UP SLOPES.

Helena, Mont., May 16.—Counsel for the Amalgamated Copper Company and the Boston and Montana Company have applied to the Supreme Court for an injunction restraining P. Augustus Heinze from operating the Minnie Healy mine, pending the appeal in the suit of the now celebrated Minnie Healy case, which reached the supreme tribunal this week. The court set the application for hearing on Tuesday, May 20.

Two affidavits filed by employees of the Amalgamated Company allegations were made to the effect that Mr. Heinze's men, since the operation of the Minnie Healy mine last June, had blown up the slopes in the 800 foot level, and it is intimated that this was done to destroy evidence as to the amount of ore abstracted.

OLD LEATHER HOUSE ASSIGNS.

ADAMS & KEEN, OF PHILADELPHIA, ARE INVOLVED FOR PROBABLY \$200,000.

[BY TELEGRAPH TO THE TRIBUNE.] Philadelphia, May 16.—Adams & Keen, leather merchants, one of the oldest firms in that business in the country, has made an assignment to Benson Mann, an attorney, with offices in the Girard Building. Members of the firm decline to make a statement to-day, but it is said that the amount involved exceeds \$200,000. The assignment is dated Wednesday, but no statement of the firm's accounts can be obtained before Monday.

The firm of Adams & Keen was established fifty years ago, and operates a large factory for the manufacture of "red kid," and has a warehouse and office here.

Newburg, N. Y., May 16.—Mrs. Jennie A. Paul was arrested this afternoon on complaint of a postoffice inspector on the charge of illegally using the mails. Mrs. Paul is a middle-aged woman. She was taken to New-York City.

He was cashier in the Controller's office during the Administrations of Peter B. Sweeney and Nelson J. Waterbury. He leaves a widow and four sons, one of whom, Jerome F. Healy, is secretary of Typographical Union No. 8.
