IMPORTS AND EXPORTS OF DARK CONTINENT—GOLD AND DIAMOND PRODUCTION.

Washington, June 6 (Special).—The declaration of peace in South Africa, which is to be followed by the reopening of the greatest gold producing mines of the world and presumably by a general revival of business in this great continent...

The commerce of Africa, according to this publication of the Bureau of Statistics, amounts to over \$700,000,000, of which \$425,000,000 represented the value of the imports...

A very large proportion of the trade of Africa is with England. There are numerous reasons for this, the most important of which are that her colonies, Cape Colony and Natal...

The total recorded imports into Africa, aggregating in the last available year \$425,461,000, were distributed as follows: Into British territory, \$157,555,000; French territory, \$92,004,000; Turkish territory, \$77,787,000; Portuguese territory, \$30,726,000; German territory, \$23,266,000; and into the Congo Free State, \$4,722,000.

The total recorded exports from Africa, aggregating in the last available year \$425,461,000, were distributed as follows: Into British territory, \$157,555,000; French territory, \$92,004,000; Turkish territory, \$77,787,000; Portuguese territory, \$30,726,000; German territory, \$23,266,000; and into the Congo Free State, \$4,722,000.
