"FLOUR OF THE FAMILY" CASE. THE PRETTY PLAINTIFF WHOSE PICTURE WAS USED FOR ADVERTISING PURPOSES NON-SUITED.

ROCHESTER, June 27.—A remarkable litigation, known throughout the State as the "flour of the family" case, which has attracted comment in this country and in Europe, was decided by the Court of Appeals to-day against the pretty plaintiff, after a long continuance in the courts.

The action is entitled "Margaret E. Bell, as guardian for Abigail Roberson, vs. the Rochester Folding Box Company and the Franklin Mills Company, of Lockport," and it was begun to recover \$1500 from the defendants for using the picture of the Roberson girl on the printed advertisements, barrels and flour sacks of the milling company.

The first step in the case was a proceeding for an injunction, restraining the defendants from using the picture. A demurrer was filed to the complaint, and the argument was heard before Supreme Court Justice John M. Davy, who handed down a decision holding that a woman's beauty is her inalienable property and not public material for advertisers, and that it tended to outrage a woman's privacy, and to injure her character and reputation.

The decision caused much comment. Chicago, San Francisco, New-York and New-Orleans papers discussed it editorially and the law magazines published the decision in full. An appeal was taken from this decision to the Appellate Court, and in March, 1902, four of the justices, the fifth not sitting, handed down an order for a re-argument, as the court was evenly divided in its findings. The case was re-argued before the Appellate Court, and the five justices were unanimous in sustaining the lower court. Permission to appeal to the higher court was asked, and in a decision handed down last October the court granted relief, but formulated these two questions to be answered by the higher court.

First—Does the complainant in the action state a cause of action against the defendants or either of them? Second—Does the complaint in the action state a cause of action against the defendants or either of them? To-day the higher court decides the questions as follows: "Roberson vs. Rochester Folding Box Company and one. Judgment reversed and questions certified answered in the negative, without costs, with leave to plaintiff to serve an amended complaint within twenty days, also without costs."

The so-called right of privacy is, as the phrase suggests, founded upon the claim that a man has a right to pass through this world, if he wills, without having his picture, portrait, or likeness, enterprises discussed or his eccentricities commented upon, either in handbills, catalogues, periodicals or newspapers, necessarily, that the things which may not be written or published of him must not be spoken of him by his neighbors, whether the comment be favorable or otherwise. If such a principle be incorporated into the body of the law through the instrumentality of a court of litigation, but in litigation bordering upon the abuse of the right of privacy, once established as a legal doctrine, cannot be confined to the restraint of the publication of a likeness, but must necessarily embrace as well the publication of a word picture, a comment upon one's looks, conduct, domestic relations or habits.
