All Around Usefulness of This Indispensable Member of a Party.

Lake Placid, N. Y., July 25 (Special).—"Say, them fellows are a-trying to make a name for themselves, ain't they?" was the comment of a weather-bronzed Adirondack guide when a guest at one of the big hotels told him that the guides of Maine, having secured the passage of a law requiring persons hunting in the Maine woods to take out a license and hire a guide, have now formed a combination under which they are able to insist not only that each guide shall be paid \$3 a day, but that each guide shall guide no more than one hunter, and also that guides shall not be required to cook.

"Not cook!" exclaimed the veteran of the Adirondack wilds. "Well, next thing they'll be a-pettinging the legislature for an appropriation for white kid gloves, Pook!" and the old fellow expressed his contempt with a vicious kick at an offending stone.

"Cook? Well, I should say we did. None of yer baker's fixins for me when I'm on the trail. I want ter know what I'm eatin', and I'm willing to do the cooking myself."

"These city folks are so thoughtless," commented one guide. "Now, on a mountain trip the women always take along a tin of cooking fat. They need it. Then they peel them off when they finally get to the top of the mountain. They put these into the basket, won't you? Into the basket they go, and the guide has to carry them. It's all right with a small party, but with a big one it's pretty rough."

"The average Adirondack guide is the soul of hospitality. He knows that nothing can be caught, he will state the situation fully and frankly, though it means the loss of \$2."

"I can go out with you if you say so," said a guide to a New-York man one day last week, "but let me frankly warn you, get out of the woods. The trip was declared off, and the guide had lost \$2."

The Adirondack guide will cook, carry a big basket of camp traps on his shoulders, tug a canoe across a stream, run errands, and even mind a baby on occasion; but there are some things he will not do. For instance, he will not "hold" a horse, and he will not "hold" a horse's boots. Attempts to have some of the guides attached to some of the big Adirondack camps "slink" in their personal appearance have not been wholly successful.


