

PASSES ITS DIVIDEND. VIRGINIA-CAROLINA. Syndicate Formed to Supply Working Capital.

Richmond, Va., Aug. 18.—The Virginia-Carolina Chemical Company directors decided this afternoon to pass the dividend on the common stock. They issued the following statement to the stockholders:

Your board of directors desire to say that for the first time since 1901, the Virginia-Carolina Chemical Company actually sold and delivered 25,000 tons of fertilizer, being an increase of 10,000 tons over the business of the preceding year.

It is understood that W. B. Chisholm, of Charleston, S. C., retires from the directorate and is succeeded by Edward T. Stotesbury, of the firm of Drexel, Morgan & Co., of Philadelphia.

FIND BASIS FOR WAGE INCREASE. Chicago Employers Decide That It Shall Be 15 Per Cent.

SHIPBUILDING CORRESPONDENCE. The Company Hopes To Be Able to Resume Work on Chattanooga and Torpedo Boats.

Washington, Aug. 18.—Acting Secretary Darling has received a dispatch from the counsel for the United States Shipping Company, of which the Crescent Shipbuilding Company is a part, stating that the company hopes eventually to be able to resume work on the cruiser Chattanooga and the torpedo boats Nicholson and O'Brien.

SUI FOR TEN MILLIONS. Effort to Foreclose Mortgage of Shipbuilding Company.

Following the permission granted by Judge Kirkpatrick on Monday in the United States District Court, New York, an action in the United States Circuit Court was begun yesterday by the New York Security and Trust Company against the United States Shipbuilding Company and James Smith, Jr., receiver, to foreclose a mortgage given by the shipbuilding company to the trust company, of twenty years to secure the payment of a series of bonds amounting to \$10,000,000.

LIMITS THE RECEIVER. Court Says Union Iron Works May Complete Contracts.

Replying to the statement published respecting the appointment of James Smith as receiver of the Union Iron Works of San Francisco, William Nelson Cromwell, of counsel for the reorganization committee, said yesterday that he was informed that Judge Bailey rendered a decision which, while recognizing the appointment of Mr. Smith as receiver of the United States Shipbuilding Company, does not permit him to enter into possession of the Union Iron Works.

CONTRACTS AGAINST STRIKES. Pledges of Workmen Said to Be Against Trouble in the Shipyards.

Henry C. Hunter, secretary of the New York Metal Trades Association, issued a statement yesterday in reference to the threat of a general sympathetic strike in all the shipyards in support of the marine machinists. The latter are on strike for a minimum wage scale of \$1 a day.

POLICE PROTECT BUILDERS. Work on a New Apartment Hotel in Madison-ave. Carried On.

The iron work on the large apartment hotel at Madison-ave. and Twenty-sixth-st., for which the Thompson-Starratt Company has the contract, went on yesterday under police protection. Four extra policemen were detailed to watch the building, but no disturbance took place.

STILL ANOTHER LEVY. Marshal on Ferryboat Bound Brook at Elizabeth Yards.

Elizabeth, N. J., Aug. 18 (Special).—The ferryboat bound Brook of the New-Jersey Central Railroad, which is undergoing extensive repairs at the New-Jersey Dock Company's plant here, has been levied on for salvage by the owners of some tugs which went to the ferryboat's assistance when it was in danger of destruction by fire some months ago.

SHERIFF NOT WARNED OFF. Elizabeth, N. J., Aug. 18 (Special).—No official notice from the United States Government was received at Sheriff Coriell's office here to-day that it had taken possession of the cruiser Chattanooga at the Crescent Shipyards. All the sheriff knows about the matter is that one of his deputies at the shipyard informed him late yesterday afternoon that United States marshals had taken charge of the cruiser and torpedo boats Nicholson and O'Brien, and were taking an account of stock of the material in the shipyard intended for use on these vessels and were placing tags on the work with the intention, it is presumed, of taking it away with the shipyard property.
