ARISE LONG EXPECTED. Colombians Here Not Surprised at News from Bogota.

Men in this city who have followed the trend of affairs in Colombia have for some months looked forward to such an uprising as is reported from Bogota.

That this situation was not unexpected even in Bogota is proved by a statement made in a speech by General Pedro Nel Ospina, a prominent Senator, in the discussion of the Panama Canal treaty.

I warn you not to carry too far your policy of oppression. Remember that the government is not in possession of all the arms that were used against it in the last rebellion.

ANOTHER RECOGNITION.

President Will Receive Varilla as Panama's Minister.

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Mr. Bunau-Varilla announced to-night that he would cable to his government, advising that he declines to accept the position of minister plenipotentiary and envoy extraordinary to the Republic of Panama.

The State Department has decided to request the authorities at Panama to receive General Reyes, who is going to the isthmus on a peace mission from Bogota.

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MAY BE NO OPEN TOWN.

ARMY MAKING PLANS.

Possibility of Sending Guards to Panama and Bogota.

Washington, Nov. 11.—The General Staff of the army has been considering to-day the possible necessity of sending troops to the isthmus. While this is not regarded as probable, it is appreciated that the necessity may arise, as may also that of sending a force to Bogota to protect the American Legation there.

The opinion of officials is that the treaty about to be negotiated will provide for a fortified canal, and that garrisons at either end of the canal zone will be provided for.

There is no thought of invading Colombia, save in the event that it becomes necessary to send a recruiting party for Minister Beupré, but the conditions are being carefully considered with that end in view.
