

VIEW OF THE NEW BRIDGE OVER THE EAST RIVER, WHICH MAYOR LOW WILL FORMALLY OPEN NEXT WEEK.

This picture of the Williamsburg bridge was made from a point midway between the anchorage and tower on the Brooklyn side, looking toward Manhattan. Owing to the great height of the trusses a similar view from the drives is the only comprehensive sight passengers can enjoy while on the structure. At the right, within the trusses, are double trolley tracks, with a footway above, elevated railway double tracks in the centre, another double track for trolley cars under the north footpath, and outside the trusses the north drive. The proposed cycle path over the elevated tracks may be abandoned.
