

STOCKS MAKE BIG BREAK.

Believed To Be a Healthy Reaction from Bull Market.

A severe and general break in prices occurred yesterday in the stock market. The weakness was evident from the opening, but it was not until around noon that the first sharp decline came.

The decline was contested in the early stages, but it gathered force as it was extended. The quick exhaustion of the buying demand on the occasional rallies was a sufficient evidence to the professional traders that the speculative position was still vulnerable.
