Court Hears Motion to Dismiss Hummel Indictments.

Arguments on the motion to dismiss the three indictments against Abraham H. Hummel were heard by Justice Davy, in the Criminal Branch of the Supreme Court, yesterday, and in the presence of the committee on grievances of the Bar Association...

"The point is well stated that no witness can be called upon to testify before the grand jury to set a foundation for accusation against himself," said Mr. Nicolli.

"The claim that the grand jury has no right to inquire into crime in a general way is so absurd and so novel that I hardly think it worthy of any serious consideration," said District Attorney Jerome, in reply.

Mr. Jerome pointed out that the subpoena served on Mr. Hummel was entitled, "Charles F. Dodge vs. Others," and said: "Would this astute criminal lawyer have any doubt as to what he was called to testify to?"
