

WAIL OF THE CHORUS.

Conried Singers' Union Ready to Make Sweeping Demands.

Christmas Day has been decided upon by the Chorus Singers' Union, consisting of members of the chorus of the Metropolitan Opera House, as the date for an agreement containing a portentous list of demands, including one for higher wages, which is to be presented to Director Heinrich Conried.

The chorus agrees to render service to the company in his or her capacity as chorus and woman or child, in all performances, concerts, oratorios, etc., to be given by the company during a term beginning on the 25th day of December, 1905, and ending on or about the 15th day of April, 1906.

The chorus further agrees to attend rehearsals two weeks before the opening of the new season, and he or she shall receive therefor a salary of \$12.50 a week.

In compensation for such services the company agrees to pay to the chorus the sum of \$25 a week, to begin with the 25th day of December, 1905.

A great number of rules are provided in the agreement as to the pay of the performers in case of sickness, the treatment of the chorus singers on the road and other matters. The union demands the right to seats in the regular day coaches during the day and berths and sleepers during the night when travelling.

The president of the new union, Herr Salzburn, was given the privilege of the floor at yesterday's meeting of the Central Federated Union, and escorted to the platform. He bowed his acknowledgments and then told of the alleged grievances of the chorus singers. He said that it required an artistic training, which involved many years of study to make a man or woman an efficient chorus singer.

Henry De Veaux, also a delegate of the Actors' Protective Union, asked to be allowed to say something. He declared that the artistic sense of any one would show that the chorus was the most essential part of grand opera. Music and the drama, he said, had an elevating influence on the people at large, and those who furnished it should be paid properly.

The musical and dramatic critics of the Central Federated Union shook their heads wisely and emphasized what De Veaux said by applause. The delegates of the waiters, bartenders and other unions in the miscellaneous trades, as well as those in the building trades, looked highly pleased at his appeal to their artistic sense.

The delegates of the Musical Mutual Protective Union said that he wanted his union to have some share in presenting the demands, which were endorsed by acclamation. After a conference was held between the Chorus Singers' Union, the Musical Mutual Protective Union and other organizations, the demands will be presented to Mr. Conried, who will be told that they are endorsed by the Central Federated Union.
