The most difficult task was to drive them from their base on the Kazan Railroad between Moscow and Perovo, three miles east of Moscow, and surround them in the Presna district so as to prevent their escape.

A man who has just returned here from Moscow accounts for the exaggeration in the reports of the slaughter there by the fact that the troops and artillery generally used blank cartridges for the purpose of frightening the insurgents.

Philadelphia, Jan. 1.—Twenty-four of the one-hundred printing firms in this city have signed the agreement giving their employees an eight-hour workday.

Washington, Jan. 1.—Because of a special agreement between the Typothetae of Washington and the local typographical union, January 4, and not January 1, is the date when the demand of the union that all shops shall be closed to non-union men and placed on an eight-hour basis is to go into effect here.

Columbus, Ohio, Jan. 1.—Twenty-one union job printing offices in Columbus today granted the eight-hour day. The union printers of Columbus yesterday voted to add the printers in New-York and elsewhere in their effort to secure the eight-hour day.

Providence, R. I., Jan. 1.—A strike of the union compositors of the local book and job printing shops, about forty-five in number, occurred today because their demand for an eight-hour day was refused.

Mitau, Jan. 1.—Four columns of troops, principally cavalry and artillery, are converging toward Mitau and Riga. The insurgents in the towns held by them are instituting a Social Democratic administration as if they were in permanent possession.

Los Angeles, Cal., Jan. 1.—On account of the holiday the full extent of the printers' strike in Los Angeles will not be known until to-morrow. It is estimated to-day that 125 printers and about a hundred apprentices will fail to report for work to-morrow, unless their demand for an eight-hour day is granted.

Stockton, Cal., Jan. 1.—The employing printers and publishers of Stockton have conceded the eight-hour day, effective to-day. Those benefited by the concession are job printers, pressmen and bookbinders.

Louisville, Ky., Jan. 1.—Sixty job printers, members of the Louisville Typographical Union, went on strike to-day for an eight-hour day and a closed shop.
