MR. BARNEY AFTER BROOKLYN.

Says Dr. Darlington Should Do More to Abate Smoke Nuisance.

Charles T. Barney, of this city, who has been carrying on a crusade in Manhattan against the soft coal smoke nuisance, announced yesterday that he intends to take up the question in Brooklyn in a vigorous manner. He will, he says, enlist the support of the many civic organizations of Brooklyn and Queens, and he hopes soon to have the support of Dr. Darlington, who, he declares, is cautious, and has not given him the proper support in his work in Manhattan.

Speaking of the smoke troubles yesterday, Mr. Barney said that Dr. Darlington had the power to stop the nuisance, but that he does not enforce the law. The Sanitary Code has been amended, he says, so that now, instead of making arrests, it is necessary to bring a civil action to recover a penalty of \$50. The code has still further been amended, so that all factories must install smoke consumers, but the thing to do, he declares, is to stop them from using soft coal.

Dr. Darlington has said that if some of the big concerns holding franchises are compelled to give up the use of soft coal they will be forced out of business. Mr. Barney does not agree with him on that point.
