M'GANN SUSPENDED INDEFINITELY. Giants' First Baseman Punished by President Pulliam for "Kicking."

(By Telegraph to the Tribune.) Cincinnati, May 14.—Dan McGann, the first baseman and captain of the Cincinnati Reds, was suspended here this morning for President Pulliam of the National League that he had been indefinitely suspended. He was ordered out of the game on Saturday by Johnston, the umpire, for finding fault with a ruling. This is the second time this season that McGann has been punished by President Pulliam.

BROOKLYN NO MATCH FOR CHICAGO. (By Telegraph to the Tribune.) Chicago, May 14.—In a game that was too one-sided to be interesting, Brooklyn lost to Chicago today by a score of 19 to 1. McIntyre pitched for the victors, and was hit freely throughout the game. The fielding of the Superbas was listless, and the Chicago players stole bases almost at will.

TROTTLING AND PACING. Many View with Alarm the Rapid Increase of Side Wheelers.

Many horsemen are viewing with alarm the rapid increase in the number of pacers in the last few years. This increase is best shown in the larger number of racing events scheduled by the various racing associations. In the last year 307 trotters were listed, and 1,041 pacers. This is a percentage of 64.69 in favor of the lateral gaited class.

Statistics show that the percentage of pacers to trotters in 1892 was 14.53. From 1892 to 1906 the racing division has shown a steady increase in percentage to trotters, as follows: 1893, 17.05; 1894, 19.32; 1895, 22.52; 1896, 24.94; 1897, 26.93; 1898, 28.96; 1899, 30.98; 1900, 31.99; 1901, 32.98; 1902, 34.91; 1903, 35.46; 1904, 36.36; 1905, 37.58. It will thus be seen that the relative number of pacers to trotters has more than doubled in the last decade.
