GAVE POISON TO INFANTS. Unknown Woman Tells Two Children That Acid Is Nice.

(By Telegraph to The Tribune.) Tonawanda, N. Y., May 19.—James Brown, a building contractor, has announced his determination to bring to justice an unknown woman who attempted to kill his girl and boy, Olive and Levant, by giving them an ounce bottle of carbolic acid, and assuring them that the pills contained "something real nice."

The children were playing in the yard in front of their home this morning when the woman approached them and gave them the poison. They took part of it. The girl was the first to drink it, and her cries caused the brother to drop the bottle after getting only a little in his mouth. The boy was soon out of danger, but the girl's condition is critical. The police have been unable to obtain a clue as to the identity of the woman. The motive for the crime is a mystery.

FRICK'S WOULD-BE SLAYER HERE. Alexander Berkman, Released Anarchist, Will Write Propaganda.

Alexander Berkman, the anarchist who tried to kill Henry C. Frick, came to this city after being released from prison in Pittsburg, Friday, and is now being cared for by Emma Goldman and the local group of anarchists of the city. Berkman, it was learned yesterday, has been in constant communication with his anarchist friends in this city, sending letters through Emma Goldman, at her home, Nos. 208 and 210 East 15th street, and addressing her as "E. Smith."

At Emma Goldman's home a friend who gave his name as John C. Frick, was seen yesterday. According to Jossil, after his wife had disappeared, he found the had taken with her \$300 of his savings. Jossil declared his sympathy with Bronzini and his wayward wife, in the hope of coaxing her back to his home and children. He also expected to get as much money back.

Last night, he said, Mrs. Jossil refused to have anything to do with him, and Bronzini refused to give him back the money. He drew his revolver and fired, first at Bronzini, and then at Mrs. Jossil. A third shot went wide and a fourth, in a struggle with the woman, struck her in the head. Under the mattress in the Bronzini apartment was found a fully loaded 38 calibre revolver and a long Sicilian dirk. Neighbors said Mrs. Jossil and Bronzini had a wife and three children in Naples.
