TRADE IN CHICAGO.

(By Telegraph to The Tribune.)

Chicago, June 2.—The market for wheat underwent a change to-day. It was strong, and at the close July was 1/2¢ higher than the best figures of the day. Corn was strong at times, but in the end the gain for the day was reduced to about 1/4¢. Oats also acted firm and closed at about 1/4¢ advance. Provisions were lower on selling by outside long.

The wheat market opened quiet and inactive, but good weather, favorable crop conditions and indications of a bullish government report caused it to become stronger, and prices advanced. Local receipts were 14 cars, with 4 cars estimated for Monday. July wheat set at high as \$1.50 to \$1.55, and closed at \$1.45, as compared with 80 1/2¢ to 85 1/2¢ at the close of the previous session.

Strength in corn was due to an active cash demand, small offerings from the interior, fine weather and crop conditions. Local receipts were 23 cars, with 70 cars estimated for Monday. Shipments hence were 46,000 bushels. The closing price for July was 49 1/2¢ to 49 3/4¢, after selling as high as 49 1/2¢. September left off at 49 1/2¢, its best for the day having been 47 1/2¢ to 50¢.

The oat market had good advances on large trade and strong demand. Reports of the growing crop were discouraging and sentiment in this market decidedly bullish. Local receipts were 128 cars, with 200 cars estimated for Monday. Shipments hence were 240,000 bushels. July oats sold as high as 84 1/2¢ to 85¢ and closed at 83 1/2¢, reacted to 85 1/2¢ and advanced to 85 1/2¢ to 86 1/2¢, reacted to 85 1/2¢ and closed at 85 1/2¢ to 86 1/2¢.

Trade in the hog products was of moderate volume, large at the beginning of the session and less later. The tendency was downward to begin with, and the selling was in the way of liquidation by the outside long. Buying by packers on the decline retarded prices to about the closing figures of yesterday.
