BOY KILLED COACHMAN. Yonkers Mystery Solved by Young Servant's Confession.

The mystery surrounding the death of James McKeon, coachman for F. L. Graves, a Wall Street broker, at Hartsdale, on Wednesday last week, has been solved.

Eddie Kinnear, a fifteen-year-old boy employed at Mr. Graves's country home, confessed to Sheriff Merritt yesterday that he did the shooting, but said it was an accident.

The boy did not make the confession until Sheriff Merritt and his deputies had worked on the case for nearly a week and had employed Pinkerton men to help them unravel the mystery.

When the boy confessed to the shooting, he said he was afraid of the coachman because he had been going out with the boy on the day of the shooting.
