

SCIENCE SESSION OVER WOULD SAVE FORESTS.

Asks Congress to Act—Will Meet at Chicago Next Year.

The final session of the convention of the American Association for the Advancement of Science was held yesterday morning at Earl Hall, Columbia University.

The first section contained a recommendation that an additional department of the association be created, to be known as Section L and to be devoted to education, and providing for the appointment of Commissioner Elmer Brown as vice-president in charge of the new section.

The American Association for the Advancement of Science again respectfully calls the attention of Congress to the increasing seriousness of the results of the rapid and reckless destruction of forests in the White Mountain and Southern Appalachian regions.

Resolved, That R. S. Woodward, Charles Walcott, C. White, W. B. Clark and Clifford W. Hartridge be appointed a committee of five to present the above resolution to the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

The entire report was adopted. Retiring President Welch thanked all those who have aided in making the convention successful, particularly the president and trustees of Columbia University and the faculties of New York University and the College of the City of New York.
