

THE COTTON ESTIMATE. Placed at 5,811,968,000 Pounds for 1907-'08.

Washington, Dec. 10.—The crop reporting board of the bureau of statistics of the Department of Agriculture, today issued a report estimating that the total production of cotton in the United States for the year 1907-'08 will amount to 3,381,968,000 bales of 50 pounds gross weight.

There was great excitement on the local cotton exchange following the announcement of the local cotton crop report promptly at 1 o'clock yesterday. The figures were considerably above the general estimate of the size of the crop, and the result was a heavy selling movement, under which the market broke 40 points, or \$2 a bale, within five minutes after the report was published.
