Market Found for the Bertha Apartment-house.

DR. G. C. MORGAN HERE.

London Preacher to Deliver Course of Lectures.

The Rev. Dr. G. Campbell Morgan, pastor of Westminster Chapel, London, England, generally acknowledged to be one of the greatest living preachers and interpreters of the Bible, is in this country for a brief period, and will deliver a course of lectures under the auspices of the New York Bible Teachers' Training School in the Fifth Avenue Presbyterian Church, Fifth avenue and Fifty-ninth street, beginning Wednesday, March 18, and continuing for six successive weekdays.

He will occupy the pulpit of the Fifth Avenue Church both morning and afternoon, Sunday, March 22. This is in accordance with an agreement made with the church officers last summer. Dr. Morgan will lecture every day at 4 o'clock in the afternoon and at 8 o'clock at night.

The subjects of Dr. Morgan's afternoon lectures in New York will be "Christian Principles," and of his evening addresses "The Messages of the Pentateuch." The individual topics for the afternoon lectures are: Wednesday, March 18, "The Spiritual Nature of Man"; Thursday, March 19, "The Direct Dealing of Man with God—A Right and an Obligation"; Friday, March 20, "The Relation of Reason and Faith"; Saturday, March 21, "The Preliminary Adjustment—Self Lost and Found"; Monday, March 23, "The Realization of Christian Life—Centre and Spine"; Tuesday, March 24, "The Passion of Christ and His Church for the Kingdom of God."

The particular topics for the night sermons are: Wednesday, "Genesis"; Thursday, "Exodus"; Friday, "Leviticus"; Saturday, "Numbers"; Monday, "Deuteronomy"; Tuesday, "The Pentateuch and Christ."

Dr. Morgan arrived in this country last Friday on the Manhattan, at the Grand Line, he being a fellow passenger with the Burnett and Lady Currier. Dr. Morgan went at once to the Murray Hill Hotel, where he always makes his headquarters when in New York, and spent the night there. The next night he went to Hartford, Conn., for a very short stay. At present he is in Atlanta.

TO DISSOLVE WESTMINSTER.

Westminster Presbyterian Church will be dissolved, it is said, and the other uptown, recently Presbyterian services were stopped, the pastor, the Rev. H. J. Mendelhall, saying there was no money to keep the church open. Yesterday the controlling authority in Presbyterian affairs in New York took the case in hand. It ordered public worship to be held in the church both morning and evening on Sundays, March 8 and 15, and on Tuesday of Tuesday, March 17, for a hearing to show cause why the church might not be dissolved. The services to-morrow and on Sunday, March 15, will be under the charge of the general authority and not of Westminster congregation.

Inquiry yesterday showed that the old trouble, partly personal and partly financial, which rent the church, had been cleared up, and that the Rev. Dr. John Lloyd Lewis was sending it still. It may be remembered that during the time of the late Rev. Dr. Lee Westminster Church formally took itself out of the New York Presbytery. The Presbytery never recognized the legality of the action. After the late pastor's death the church withdrew from the New York Presbytery, a heavy withdrawal, but the property is worth \$200,000. Services will not be discontinued and the church permanently closed. Instead, its affairs will be put into the hands of the session of some well known Presbyterian church, possibly the Central
