

When Dr. Greer was elected coadjutor bishop five years ago he showed his disregard for the conventional by declining to receive an episcopal ring and pectoral cross.

MAY ASK FOR COADJUTOR. By Bishop Potter's death last week Bishop Greer immediately became the spiritual head of the New York diocese.
