

JUSTICE FITS SO RULES.

Is Constitutional, Court Says—Buffalo Company Under Jurisdiction.

Albany, March 27.—Supreme Court Justice Fitts today handed down a decision in which he holds that the Public Service Commission's law is constitutional and that the Economic Power and Construction Company of Buffalo is under the jurisdiction of the 2d District Commission and must make reports to it.
