

COTTON ON SLIDE

Trenton, N. J., Jan. 14.—Vice-Chancellor Walker today granted a preliminary injunction against the Hudson County Water Company restraining it from laying pipes under the Kill Van Kull for the purpose of supplying Staten Island with water taken from driven wells near Belleville. The company claimed a right to lay the pipes under a riparian grant made by the state to the Guttry Petroleum Company and a license obtained from the Secretary of War.
