

News of the Markets

BUTTER, EGGS AND POULTRY. Dairy products at Washington Market are much lower this week. Butter has dropped the cents on the pound, the price now standing at 26 cents for fresh butter and 28 cents for sweet.

MEAT. The meat market is still demoralized. Lamb has gone up a cent a pound, and though beef is the same as it was last week, the present adding cost to the wholesale handler is already making itself felt among the retailers.
