

MORE ARRESTS SOON

IN CAMBRIDGE CASE.

Boston District Attorney Investigating Fara Scandals.

Boston, March 4.—Persistent rumors in circulation to-day regarding the possibility of more arrests in connection with the wrecking of the National City Bank of Cambridge had not been fully rebutted.

Lockhart appeared before United States Commissioner Hayes, pleaded not guilty, and was remanded to jail in default of \$20,000 bail.
