The front faces on 42d street, with a bridge crossing that busy thoroughfare to the Park avenue slope. Under the vacant blocks to the north lie the tracks, switches and general mechanism of the huge train yard. The surface of these vacant blocks will be occupied by fine buildings, devoted to commerce or the arts. Park avenue is seen stretching away to the north. It is split by the new station, and runs around both sides of it, joining again at the bridge over 42d street. Cost of the new terminal is estimated at \$180,000,000.
