## GREAT CATHEDRAL OF ST. JOHN THE DIVINE JUST BEGINNING TO REVEAL ITS INNER BEAUTY.

PHOTOGRAPH OF THE SANCTUARY, SHOWING THE NEWLY ERECTED REREDOS, THE GIGANTIC COLUMNS AND THE CATHEDRAL CHOIR BOYS.



Each of these columns cost \$25,000, is 6 feet in diameter at the base and 90 feet high. They are set at unequal distances from one another in order to make them appear even. On the wall spaces behind, seen between the columns, costly tapestries will hang. A guarantee has now been secured for \$55,000 for the maintenance of public worship for five years after the opening of the cathedral next winter.
