M'LOUGHLIN WINS EASILY. Beats Charlock in State Tourney Without Extending Himself. JOHNSON IN FAST MATCH. Pell, the Intercollegiate Champion, Goes Down Before Pennsylvania's Drives.

Lawn tennis experts who watched the racket work of Maurice E. McLaughlin, the international star from the Pacific Coast, yesterday in the third round of the New York State championship tournament on the turf courts of the Crescent Athletic Club, at Bay Ridge, decided that he was not making an effort to show his best game. McLaughlin took his chances and still he managed to hold his own, defeating Miles S. Charlock, once the major-domo of the East Jersey League, by the score 5-1, 6-2.

Naturally McLaughlin attracted the greater part of the gallery that surrounded the courts. His speed was at all times a surprise to the youth who did not reveal any of his tricks, for the simple reason that he was not forced to do so, for whenever he had needed a point it was almost always possible for him to win it by forcing Charlock out of position and then shooting over a swift pass.

The best of the lawn tennis of the third day of the great tournament was displayed in the match in the fourth round, in which Wallace F. Johnson, the young Pennsylvanian who holds the intercollegiate championship, defeated the New England title holder, Theodore Roosevelt Pell, 6-2, 6-2 and 9-7. It is a player ever put his back to the test and used his backhanders so splendidly won points, then Pell accomplished the feat in this match.

The other Californian, Carleton R. Gardner, played well and rather easily disposed of the Harvard man, Alfred Stillman, 6-2, 6-4. For the doubles afternoon, Gardner was paired with McLaughlin. Another expert who seems due for a surprise in the way of scoring a sensational win is Richard H. Palmer, the New Jersey champion, who defeated the former Columbia University expert, Robert Cassano, 6-1, 6-2.

Lawn tennis players of Park Hill won two of the championship titles yesterday in the tournament of the Westchester County Association on the clay courts of the Stuyvesant Country Club, Mount Vernon. Playing a fine and swift driving game, Mrs. Henry H. Burdick and Miss Anna Martin scored in the women's doubles in straight sets, with the loss of only one game. In the final of the event they defeated the Peilman Manor pair, Miss Elizabeth Mills and Miss Cooke, 6-1, 6-0.

Previous to this match Mrs. Burdick and Miss Martin had met and defeated the Rye pair, Miss Gardin and Miss Nash, in the semi-final by the score of 6-2, 6-2. That the women of the Park Hill club were at the top of their game was made evident when they faced each other across the net as opponents in the championship final of the mixed doubles. When play was adjourned for the day Spielmann and Tarrasch had the better positions against Tartakower and John, respectively. EVANS TO DEFEND TITLE. Will Play Phelps To-day for Western Championship. SHARP CONTESTS YESTERDAY. Both Golfers in Close Matches While Fighting Their Way to Finish. Minneapolis, July 29.—Charles Evans, Jr., of Edgewater, will defend his title as Western champion against Mason E. Phelps, of Midolthian, in the finals of the Western Golf Association tournament at the Minikahda Club, to-morrow. It will be a meeting of champions, as Phelps won the Western honors at the Rock Island tournament in 1908.

Chick Evans, as his friends call him, won his way into the final round by defeating Robert E. Hunter, of Midolthian, in a hotly contested thirty-nine-hole match in the semi-finals to-day by 1 up. Phelps defeated Warren K. Wood, of Homewood, by 5 up and the Western champion gave one of the most marvellous exhibitions of golfing nerve ever seen on Western links. Hunter was dormie 1 playing the eighteenth hole in the afternoon round, but Evans made a remarkable 3 in the face of golfing difficulties that would have overwhelmed any one not of championship calibre. With the match even, they started the thirty-second hole.

Playing that hole it appeared as if the fates had doomed Evans to defeat, but his friends stopped him from giving up the hole. Evans' drive went into the first bunker, and he lost a stroke getting out. Hard luck still followed him, and he overstepped the sand trap on the far side of the green. Another stroke was lost there, and he missed on the edge of the green by 4. He missed a long put for a 5, and was ready to give up the hole, but his friends advised him to wait until Hunter had putted. Hunter's second was short and he overstepped on his third. He took three puts for a 3; Evans holed out in 4, and the match was still on. Hunter was hole-high on the second, but on the edge of the green. Evans' second was sixty yards short, but he laid his approach almost dead to the hole, and it was halved in 4.

The strain was beginning to tell on Hunter, and he wobbled badly going to the third. The third hole is at the top of a hill, and it is a long hole. Hunter's pitch was short and rolled back down the hill. He put his second too far over, and his third too far back toward the tee. He finally lay on the green in 4 and missed a put for a 5. Evans had better luck, and holed for a 4, giving him the hole and a victory in the hardest fought match of the tourney. Evans was 1 down at the end of the morning round as Hunter came in well after being 1 down at the turn. The match was evened when Evans won the first hole 6-5, after Hunter got into the bunker at the far side of the green and lost a stroke getting out. Evans also went in, but got out on the green in 3. On the second Evans ran down a 15-foot put for a hole in 4. Hunter's pitch was short on the third, and Evans won 3-4, making him 1 up. Hunter went into a bunker on the fourth and Evans won, 5-7, making him 2 up. The fifth and sixth were halved in par figures, Evans rimming the cup for a 3 on the latter hole.

Autopsy Shows That Alois Vey Did Not Die of Heart Disease. An autopsy performed by Coroner's Physician Lehane at the morgue yesterday morning brought to light the fact that Alois Vey, who died in a sawmill at West 24th street on Thursday night, died of a violent mania instead of from heart disease, as the foreman of the place originally reported. The physician is satisfied that the report was an error, however, and will drop the case. When Dr. Lehane went to the mill after the report of the death, he examined the body and found a triangular bruise on the forehead and a triangular bruise on the back of the head. The body removed to the morgue, he ordered an autopsy after he found the bruise. He discovered yesterday morning that the fifth and sixth ribs had been broken and the heart ruptured. In the mean time two workmen in the place made affidavit to the fact that they had seen the piece of wood strike Vey in the breast while he was cutting it on a buzz saw. Members of the firm owning the mill explained that the men were not around when the foreman made his report, and said they believed the man had died of heart disease.
