The Bolted Door

BEFORE you are given a few hints about our forthcoming SUNDAY MAGAZINE we wish to prepare you for a new serial, a story about New York ultrafashionable folk and a rank outsider who gets in by way of matrimony. Of course you may guess right; but the chances are that you are mistaken. It's not that kind of tale at all; but never so much more unusual and interesting.

It begins with an extract from a will. No, the will wasn't lost; in fact, it was in fine working order. And when you read that first paragraph you'll need no urging at all to go on with the story, which is really brilliantly written. It is by George Gibbs, who is not content with the reputation he has won as painter and illustrator, but must enter the writing field as well. He writes even better than he paints, which is praise he will probably not like at all. **The Bolted Door** is a strong story, almost a novel in the clearness and cleverness of its character drawing and the picturesque fidelity with which it presents phases of modern life. Its people are real and human.

Before you may begin the new serial you will have two fine instalments of the present one. And there are other particularly good things in our next SUNDAY MAGAZINE.

GENERAL NELSON A. MILES goes after Congress because proper appropriations haven't been made for aeroplanes for war use. When one of the greatest living experts on war takes that position, what he says is worth reading. General Miles has been interested in flying machines. He has been studying them closely. PLAYING HAROLD BOTH WAYS Shorty McCabe story, of course, you know what it is like, because there is no friend you know better than you do him. You stop to think of it in that way? And think what a dependable, true blue friend he is! No matter how miserable you may be, deep seated is your grouch, you always turn to Shorty with the absolute certainty he will not only make you laugh, but cheer you up, make you feel a whole lot better. You can't say that about many people.

THE HEART OF TADUSHI, by B. Powell, is a specially fine story. You remember that from time to time we have a few words of wisdom, mostly in humor, about the servant question. This belongs to the series, which wasn't planned all, one writer being moved by reading the others had written. This is our best story, not because it is about that real human benefactor, a good cook, but because what it stands for.
