Cross Must Be Placed Before Each Republican Candidate to Win.

Prosecutor's Brilliant Record Well Known in Nation as Well as State.

The candidates on the Republican ticket are all well known. None of them, however, is so widely known as District Attorney Whitman, whose record is familiar to every voter in the state, while some of the achievements in his fight against graft and corruption in public and civil life are known wherever newspapers are printed.

To vote for the Republican candidates it is necessary to make a cross (x) with a black lead pencil in the square or rectangular space to the left of their names.

Following are brief sketches of District Attorney Whitman and his running mates on the state ticket, and also of James W. Wadsworth, jr., candidate for United States Senator.

For Governor—Charles Seymour Whitman was graduated at Amherst College and taught until his appointment to the bar. Appointed an Assistant Corporation Counsel by Mayor Low, he represented the interests of New York City at Albany in the legislative sessions of 1902 and 1903.

The states which will vote upon woman suffrage are Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, Nevada, North Dakota, South Dakota and Ohio.

State-wide prohibition will be voted on in California, Colorado, Oregon, Washington and Ohio.

The states which will elect Governors on Tuesday are Alabama, Arizona, California, Colorado, Connecticut, Georgia, Idaho, Iowa, Kansas, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Nevada, New Jersey, New York, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Vermont, Wisconsin and Wyoming.

One of the sidelights of the campaign that is attracting attention is the efforts of Senator La Follette in Wisconsin to defeat both Republican and Democratic candidates for Governor with a candidate of his own.

Colonizing on a gigantic scale has been carried on in this city by Tammany Hall, according to the evidence gathered by the associations whose self-imposed duty is to prevent crimes at the ballot box.

District Attorney Whitman will cease to be a partisan to-morrow, and will be at his office to aid in preventing election frauds.

The greater part of the colonizing has been done on the lower East Side. Boverly lodging houses and other "places of stay" are crowded with repeaters who hope to be able to vote, thanks to the Tammany joker in the law.

Hundreds of these repeaters, floaters, guerrillas and colonizers are apt to find themselves crowding some "place of stay" as the Tombs or one of the other city prisons if they attempt to vote.

The District Attorney's office has called upon the Volunteer Watchers' League, with a membership of 8,000 college men, to help safeguard the polls to-morrow, and the 8,000 to a man have responded.

In issuing the call the District Attorney's office made it plain that the men who would act as watchers were such as would not be intimidated, and who knew how to take care of themselves in a physical encounter.

INDEPENDENTS TO VOTE FOR WHITMAN

Body of Old Tammany Men Pledged to Republican Ticket.

The Independent Democracy of the City and County of New York, an organization with branches in every Assembly district, met last night at its headquarters, 496 Eighth av., and passed resolutions endorsing District Attorney Whitman for Governor.

The resolutions began with a denunciation of the raising of the religious issue in the present campaign as a clumsy trick of Tammany Hall.

Speakers at last night's meeting pointed out that the "Guardians of Liberty," the body whose name was signed to some of the cards which were sent to the President to sever all organization of educated men, whereas the cards were worded in poor English, such as might have been written by an ignorant Tammany henchman.

The resolutions also condemn Governor Glynn for playing false with President Wilson. As the resolutions had it, Governor Glynn obviously had no right to the President to sever all Tammany relations before the indorsement of the Wilson administration was given to him, but that "the Governor still maintains his connection with Tammany."

M'ANENY PLEADS FOR HOME RULE

Wants New York to Have Veto Right on Legislative Acts Affecting City.

A return to the legislative method that gave the Mayor of New York City the right to veto bills relative to city affairs, passed by the State Legislature, was strongly advocated last night by George M'Aneny, president of the Home Rule League, in an address before the Manhattan Congregational Church, Broadway and 75th st.

"I do not contend that school teachers' salaries should be increased," said Mr. M'Aneny, "but I emphatically believe that the question of that kind should have been put up to the city, and final judgment vested in the Board of Estimate and Apportionment."

President M'Aneny reviewed the financial state of city government since the beginning of commerce 300 years ago, and spoke particularly of the budget passed at the Saturday night meeting of the board.

Mr. M'Aneny also went on record as opposed to the present personal salary of the Mayor, which he said was "millions of dollars being saved by the city by standardizing supplies and changing the methods of buying."
