

GERMAN FLAG BURNED IN MILAN

Rome, May 11.—At a demonstration protesting against the sinking of the Lusitania last night, in Milan, under the leadership of the editor of the Socialist "Popolo d'Italia" a German flag was burned on the steps of the cathedral. The conservative "Corriere della Sera" says: "While bodies from the Lusitania are floating on the Irish coast Germany can scarcely suppose Italy capable of sympathizing with the spirit which poisons wells in Africa and uses asphyxiating gases in Flanders. This outbreak of savagery shows how the Latin character differs from the German and makes us proud to be Latins."

FRENCH PRESS GERMAN BACK ON ARRAS LINE

Capture Strong Lorette Position and Take Long Series of Trenches.

INVADERS ON AISNE FRONT IMPERILED

Joffre's Drive Threatens Foe's Communications—Belgians Win Way Across Yser.

London, May 11.—In the desperate battle which is raging along a great part of the battlefield from the North Sea, through Belgium and Northern France, almost as far as Arras, the French have won notable advance. According to to-night's official report of the French War Office, they have taken long lines of German trenches north of Arras. One position captured, the chapel of Notre Dame de Lorette, is described as a "veritable fortress." The Germans have defended this vigorously for many months.

German Line Threatened.

The greatest importance is attached to the French operations, as it threatens the German lines of communication for the armies on the Oise and the Aisne. The result of this battle, which doubtless will not be decided for days, is awaited with deep interest. The German line, which has been damaged by allied airmen, have brought up reinforcements by motor cars. These have been met by the continuing fire of the French artillery. In fact, the artillery is becoming more and more the determining factor in the war.

British Mow Down Foe.

Nevertheless, the British found some kind of shelter, and when the German infantry tried to advance they were mowed down. There are no signs, however, of a slackening of the Germans' attacks. They are reported to be concentrating more divisions in Belgium ready to take the place of, or give support to, those now on the firing line. Many experts believe that the biggest effort yet undertaken to reach the French coast ports is now under way.

"The fighting in Northern France and Belgium elicited two lengthy statements from the War Office to-day. The latest one says: "To the north of Dixmude, the Belgian troops, who have succeeded in throwing up a bridge head on the right bank of the Yser, were subjected to violent attacks by three German battalions last night. The Belgians repulsed these, inflicting on the enemy heavy losses and taking about fifty prisoners."

Measles Shift Meeting Place.

Because of measles, which quarantines the Home for the Friendless, at 354 Woodbury Avenue, the American Female Guardian Society will hold its meeting this morning in the parlor of the Madison Avenue Baptist Church, Madison Avenue and Thirty-first Street. The Rev. John R. Mackay, D. D., pastor of the North Presbyterian Church, will make an address, and a resume of the year's work will be given.

MANY VOICES IN ITALY RAISED AGAINST WAR

Influential Party Sees No Ultimate Benefit in Wringing Concessions from Austria-Hungary—Triest the Stumbling Block.

On the Italian frontier (via Paris), May 11.—The opinion prevails in Rome that Italy's participation in the war is only a question of days. Along the Austrian frontier, where the correspondent of The Associated Press has been from one end of the line to the other, it is universally felt that war is a question only of hours.

RUSSIAN ARMY IN SOUTH POLAND STARTS RETREAT

Abandons Strong Positions on Nida River, Vienna Report Says.

AUSTRIAN FORCES CROSS RIVER SAN

Czar's Forces Repulsed Near Bukovina Frontier—Gain Footing Across Dniester.

London, May 11.—The Russians have abandoned their strongly entrenched lines along the river Nida, in southern Poland, and begun a general retreat. This action, the announcement states, was forced by the advance of the Austro-Germans around Tarnow, in Galicia.

Russian Lines Pierced.

Following is the German official announcement of the battles in Galicia: "The Russians yesterday attempted to arrest the pursuit of our army under General von Mackensen on the Brzesko-Brozowa line, on the branch of the Stronik-Brzeska, and at Ropozza, northeast of Hecha and Szczyzna, on the Vistula. Their object failed completely. By night the Russian lines were pierced in many places, especially at Brzesko and between Brzesko and Lutowa, after a desperate attack by several Russian divisions failed in the morning, with very heavy losses for the enemy. The pursuit continued."


