Records of League Open. "We have nearly twelve thousand members in the Navy League proper," he said, "and in the woman's section there are nearly thirty thousand representatives. The books of the Navy League are and always have been open to public inspection, and we are at all times most pleased to render a financial account of ourselves to any one who may be sufficiently interested to ask for such an account. We most certainly feel that before Mr. Bryan made his charges of subsidy and corruption against the Navy League he should have called on us and investigated the matter."

League Challenges Bryan. Mr. Dadmun's letter said: "Mr. William J. Bryan, Washington, D. C. 'Dear Sir: In your newspaper, 'The Commoner,' and in your public utterances, you have repeatedly declared that the Navy League is a 'subsidized organization, supported by the contribution of armor plate manufacturers.'"
