### Greater Finish of Harvard Football Eleven Also Likely to Count in Bitter Struggle on Gridiron at Cambridge To-day.

Captain Eddie Mahan is the rock on which the Yale gunboat is likely to founder. This player in his way is as wonderful as Tom Shevlin. He does everything well. And because of his individual brilliancy in running, passing and kicking, the arms of any well organized offense, the THREAT of Mahan is almost as potent an asset for the Crimson—an asset of which the wily Haughton has taken full advantage.

Yale may rise to great heights. The incentive is there, the spirit is willing, the flesh even is strong, but in every analysis the conclusion is always the same—the Harvard team is more finished. Everything else being equal, this extra finish, which is nothing more than the concentrated essence of team effort, is bound to measure the difference between winning and losing.


