

THE END OF A GERMAN BIPLANE OVER THE FRENCH FRONT



An extraordinary picture showing how Lieutenant Hannes von Koenig and Sergeant Oscar Berger, of the German Military Aviation Corps, after flying over the French and British positions and dropping air bombs, met their deaths. Captain Pierre Brettinaire, of the Allied Scouting Corps, who was flying directly over the German machine, battled for over thirty minutes before sending it down. Both the pilot and scout dropped from the German raider after the engine exploded.
