

CAMPFIRE WINS THE HOPEFUL AT SARATOGA PARK

Three Big Features Mark Closing of Racing Meet at the Spa.

Saratoga, N. Y., Aug. 26.—One of the most successful race seasons in the history of the Saratoga Association was brought to a close this afternoon before a tremendous crowd. All through the season the sport has been blessed by almost continuous fine weather, and from the opening day to the closing there never before has been shown such a lively interest in the thoroughbred horse.

The Hopeful resulted in another magnificent victory for Richard T. Wilson's Campfire, winner of the Saratoga Special and the Sanford Memorial earlier in the meeting. Today he took up 130 pounds, giving away lumps of weight to every starter and standing a stretch drive gamely, and beat home Omar Khayyam, the imported colt, that raced for C. K. G. Billings. Third went to A. K. Macomber's Star Master.

The race run by Omar Khayyam was probably more impressive than that of the winner, because the very important fact that Campfire was giving the Billings' colt twenty pounds. Buxton, who had the mount on Omar, broke a small bone in his wrist yesterday while cranking his automobile, and when no other suitable rider could be engaged he rode with his wrist wrapped with adhesive tape.

This was a serious handicap, and the fact that Omar left the barrier slowly and had to race around the entire field made his a wonderfully good performance.

The Hopeful was worth \$18,850 to the winner, but it did not cost the association a penny, as it was a guaranteed affair, with \$17,500, the gross amount promised. Of course, under the rules the excess went to the purse.

The Cup was won in handy fashion by August Belmont's good three-year-old Friar Rock, when he beat home Andrew Miller's Roamer and H. C. Hallenbeck's The Finn. Welship, who has not lost a race through the Saratoga in the Beverwyck, and in a wonderfully game finish he beat H. W. Sage's Martian.

Before the races, Dodge, winner of the Latona and the American Derby, was sold at public auction, going to A. K. Macomber for \$17,500.

MALLORY'S YACHT RANI WINS IN ARROW CLASS



BLOOD POISONING MAY COST JEFFRIES ARM







NEW ROCHELLE CLUB RACE IS WON BY ZILPH

Lena Is First of "Thirties" to Cross the Line in Sound Cruise.

By CAPTAIN JAMES C. SUMMERS. Commodore A. P. Bennett, of the New Rochelle Yacht Club, and its bustling regatta committee, with George C. Molloy, as chief hustler, were congratulated last night by every yachtsman who sailed in the club's "summer" regatta, for not only did sixty yachts cross the starting line, but the race from start to finish was one of the most successful sailed on the Sound this season.

Of the six "forties" that raced over the eleven and a half mile course, the Zilph, owned by James E. Hayes, Jr., was the winner by 2 minutes 4 seconds from James Bishop's Pamparo. Harold Wessen's Shawara was third. Ogden Reid's Lena proved the winner among the "thirties." She defeated L. G. Hamersley's Okee III by 1 minute 10 seconds. Six started in this class, and they covered the same course as the "forties."

A feature of the day's sport was the appearance, in the "B" class, of two of the sloops from Boston waters, that are to sail in the Manhasset Cup races to-morrow. The Hayseed IV, formerly the Michigan, won in the class, beating the Aleda, by 3 minutes 47 seconds. The Natives III was third.

The start was made in a fresh breeze from the southwest that increased in strength during the last half of the race. It gave the yachts a reach for the first leg of the course from the buoy of Hicks' ledge buoy to the buoy of Parsonage Point; a beat from there to the Mott's Point buoy and a broad reach from the weather end of the line. The "forties" were sent away first, and they made a pretty start. All six of them ran parallel to the line until the signal, when they kept off and crossed with sheets eased to port under good headway. J. E. Hayes's Zilph was the leader at the lee end of the line, with the Bowdy on her weather beam, the Pamparo, Mistral and Shawara crossing almost beam and beam in that order toward the weather end of the line, and the Black Duck close to the lee end, with her wind clear.

Next away were the "B" class sloops, led by the Hayseed IV. The Natives III, another sloop from the East, was second away, just under the lee of J. W. Alker's Aleda, which had the weather berth. Clifford Mallory's Joyant crossed at the lee end of the line. All three carried balloon jibs for the reach to the eastward.

The "thirties" had Ogden Reid's Lena for their leader on the next signal. She crossed at the lee end of the line. L. G. Hamersley's Okee III, steered by Robert Malsted, was second at the weather end, with the Juanita to windward and the Adois and Lesmana to leeward of her. The Alera, taking the mid-course. At 2:25 the "Q" sloops, Virginia and Arvia, got away, the former leading by a length.
