

Concrete Ship Men Assert Hurley Has Denied Hearing

Petition To Be Sent Wilson Asking Right to Build More Boats for U. S.

Victor Coxhead Says New Style of Vessels Would Save Time and Labor

An alleged refusal by Edward N. Hurley, chairman of the United States Shipping Board to approve a proposal of private capital to build forty concrete ships in addition to the forty which the government has contracted for, has led to the tentative organization here of the International Concrete Ship Association.

Victor Coxhead, of Seattle Wash., was made temporary chairman. The members of the organization are to meet at the Hotel McAlpin Wednesday night to approve a report to President Wilson on the unsatisfactory condition of the concrete ship building situation that has been drafted by a committee of engineers, of which Edward H. Beckert, of New York, is chairman.

Mr. Pell explained yesterday some of the circumstances that led to the organization of the concrete ship advocates. He said that he went to Washington recently and laid before Chairman Hurley a proposal of a syndicate of American shippers to place contracts for concrete cargo steamers to be operated under the American flag.
