

Railroad Men Told By McAdoo to Limit Wage Demands

There is a Point Beyond Which Public Will Not Sustain Increase, He Says

Refuses One Request Declines Supplementary Advances, Recently Granted, Retroactive to Jan. 1

WASHINGTON, Nov. 29.—Director General McAdoo has ruled against consideration by the board of railroad wages and working conditions of complaints filed by certain classes of railroad employees, asking that supplementary wage advances recently granted be made retroactive to January 1, 1918, as was the general wage advance of last May 25.


