

Special Features

The Easy Vacuum Electric Washer *does not rub, drag, jerk or tumble* the clothes. It cleans by a more scientific and efficient method.

Two vacuum cups move up and down, forcing the hot soapy water through the mesh of the garments on the downward stroke and sucking it through them on the upward stroke. This constant movement of the water through the clothing loosens and removes all the dirt and foreign substance from them.

Construction—The tub and cover are built of solid copper. The frame is enamelled steel and the center post, driving rod and vacuum cups are brass and copper. Nothing to rust.
Capacity—10 sheets, or 14 pounds of dry clothes.
Cost of Operating—About one cent per hour for current to wash as much as a good laundress will wash over the washboard in four hours.
Compactness—Occupies floor space 26 x 27 inches, little more than an ordinary wash tub. Will pass through any ordinary door. Three legs adjust themselves to uneven floor. Round tub with driving mechanism underneath—nothing in the way.

Wringer—Swings in any desired position and works independently of washer, enabling operator to wring clothes while washing in one continuous operation. Enclosed gears.
Motor—Under tub. 1-6 H. P. Well-known standard make (Robbins & Meyers or General Electric). Adjustable motor belt.
Gas Heater—Attaches under tub and maintains water at desired temperature.
Simplicity—No delicate parts to get easily out of order. Only two levers—one starts and stops the washer; the other starts, stops or reverses the wringer.
