Mrs. Bosworth was widely known as a constant
and discriminating collector. Her attention
was particularly directed towards 18th Century
English and early American (Colonial) works.
Her extensive gathering includes noteworthy
Wedgwood, Leeds and Staffordshire pottery,
Oriental porcelains, cabinet pieces of interest,
18th Century English and early American ma-
hogany furniture, among which are some pieces
made by Duncan Phyffe. There is also a very
noteworthy series of necklaces formed of old
Egyptian beads dating from the XII Dynasty
onwards, and some iridescent Roman and Greek
glass.
