

**Imperator Sails, After Waiting Tide, With 2,600 Aboard**

Sir Joseph Ward, ex-Premier, Calls Exchange Only Bar to Large Trade Between U.S. and New Zealand

The Cunard liner Imperator, which was held in port beyond her scheduled sailing time to take advantage of slack high water, left port last night with 2,600 passengers for Cherbourg and Southampton.

Among the saloon travelers were Sir Joseph and Lady Ward, who made a hurried trip across the Continent after their arrival on the Pacific Coast from New Zealand. Sir Joseph, who has been Premier and Minister of Finance of New Zealand, said he was out of politics and was going to England on a vacation. He said the only thing that stood in the way of an immense trade between the United States and New Zealand was the present rate of exchange.

Solomon R. Guggenheim, accompanied by Miss Barbara Guggenheim and Major and Mrs. N. R. Guggenheim, was among the Imperator's passengers. Mr. Guggenheim said that a laudable desire on the part of the European nations to readjust their financial conditions and the present rate of exchange had caused a slowing up of business of all kinds. A salutary effect on this country, he said, had been to restrict exports. If this

continued it would have the effect of reducing prices in the United States. Mr. Guggenheim expressed the belief that supply and demand still controlled the situation, and that the present uncertainties of trade were due in a great measure to the working out of this law. Among others on the Imperator were Joseph Mercedante, president of the Green Star Line; Major and Mrs. John Charles Oakes Marriott; Mrs. Vincent Astor; the Right Rev. James R. Lucas, Bishop of the Mackenzie River Diocese of the Protestant Episcopal Church; the Right Rev. P. M. Rhinolander, Episcopal Bishop of Pennsylvania; Mrs. Louis Stuyvesant Chanler; Colonel Jefferson De Mont Thompson and Mrs. Jesse Lewisohn.

The steamship Martha Washington, which was put into South American service and operated by the United States Shipping Board, arrived here yesterday from Brazil and the Argentine, with 164 passengers, including Julius Klein, commercial attaché of the Embassy at Buenos Ayres, and Charles Hoover, American consul at Rio de Janeiro.

**Gen. Gorgas Seriously Ill Rallied Several Days Ago. After Hope Had Been Abandoned**

LONDON, June 17.—The condition of Major General William C. Gorgas, formerly surgeon general of the United States army, is much more serious than his friends heretofore have been willing to admit, it was learned here today.

It is reported that three or four days ago hope for the general's recovery was abandoned, but he rallied. While there has been some improvement, however, General Gorgas is still dangerously ill.
