

Cross-Atlantic Travel Booked Months Ahead

Although U. S. Merchant Marine Has Tumbled Since 1914, Passenger Accommodations Are Inadequate

Heavy Second and Third Class Passage for Next 5 Years, Despite High Cost

Although the gross tonnage of the American merchant marine has increased from 5,368,000 to 16,049,000 since 1914, there is still a dearth of ships which has sent passenger rates skyward and caused a scarcity of accommodations.
