Two others of Newark party, who visited New York to get liquor, are ill; one affected with blindness. Poison is found in dregs. Survivors say two bottles of drink were purchased in place near Chatham Sq.

Cyanide of potassium in whisky purchased on the Bowery Saturday night killed two men in Newark yesterday. Two others in serious conditions in a Newark hospital are alive because their stomachs revolted against the action of the poison and refused to hold it, or because the whisky in the bottle they drank from was less poisonous than that which killed the other two.
