Mrs. Harding Here for Rest; Defers Shopping and Interviews

Small Army of Newspaper Women Invades Hotel, Only to Have Wife of President-Elect Postpone Audience Until To-day; She Pleads Fatigue

The wife of the President-elect of the United States has the well-known falling of her sex. With a small army of newspaper men, women and camera operators thronging to get within reach of her yesterday, she bravely changed her mind and sent a definite message to the hall of the Ritz-Carlton Hotel that postponed the attack until 10 o'clock to-day.

"I love you all," she said, and pleaded fatigue, setting 5 o'clock yesterday for a gathering of the newspaper forces. When 5 o'clock arrived there was a small group of women reporters such as is rarely seen even in this city.

"I intend to inquire thoroughly into all the circumstances of the tragedy," said Mr. Garven, "and if it develops that there was any violation of the law, prosecutions will be initiated immediately. My investigation also will take up the manner in which the hotel was conducted by the management."

Pierre J. Garven, Hudson County Prosecutor, yesterday began his investigation into the circumstances surrounding the fire in the Colonial Hotel, 41 Newark Street, Hoboken, last Saturday night, which has so far resulted in thirteen deaths. Two other victims are in St. Mary's Hospital so badly burned that physicians hold slight hope for their recovery.
