In Current Exhibitions (Continued from preceding page) ner, there being five portraits, including a spirited head of Miss Almina Chaffee and four bas relief studies. Christine Lumsdon's "Madame Butterfly" and Gladys Lee Willes' "1875" are full of simplicity and charm. Maud Strong has the largest group, one of sixteen examples. The show will remain until May 15.

Of those who assumed the painting of bird life in the wake of the master Audubon, Louis Agassiz Fuertes is one who is doing much to keep open this avenue of art with its educational possibilities. It is through such as he that art finds its way through obstructing growths to the heart of nature, revealing with vivid reality the habits and character of its creatures. These bird paintings by Fuertes at the galleries of Kennedy & Co. are contributions both to art and science. Done in water color they are less brilliant than the Audubon prints but no less informative in their detail and interpretation of bird character. Fuertes gives substance and atmosphere to his paintings, picturing his birds in their proper habitat and in other ways revealing himself as a thoroughgoing student of nature. "Ruffed Grouse," a colorfully painted study of flamingoes, and the stately "Osprey" have strongly defined characteristics that reveal keenness of observation in the painter. One oil is shown of wild geese descending to the surface of a lake. In it the artist has sacrificed detail to give play to broader scope in composition. The group stands up well in comparison with the fine Audubon prints that are hung in the same room. There is also a group of ship models of English types. They are cleverly fashioned miniatures in boxwood, one of which is a snugly-rigged replica of an East India trader.

Two English etchers, W. Lee-Hankey and Edmund Blampied, have a good sized representation of their etchings at the Ackermann Galleries. There also is a comprehensive group by Troy Kinney. The latter's work has received much merited attention from collectors and dealers here. The other two are perhaps better known abroad. Lee-Hankey makes a strong play of linear effects in his studies of Breton peasantry, which are most picturesque. His technique is strong, but there is softness in his treatment of mass that makes for delicacy. "A Corner of a Fish Market," "The Milkmaid" and "Minding the Flock" reveal a healthy treatment of form and character. Blampied works in a simple, direct style and achieves some interesting results in action that singularize him in this respect. In his several sketches of horses and the boy and dog study "Fetch It" there is lively quality. Kinney's etching is impressive in its deft, sketchy treatment, his method being exceedingly well adapted to the interpretation of the verve of the dance.

George Senseney presents some unusual effects in etching in color at the Brown-Robertson gallery. They are divided into three groups—examples done in Europe, a Connecticut series and a late American series of various subjects. Fifteen or more are landscape prints, in which the artist has reached the height of his style. This is of charming color effects achieved by a process of reprinting for each variation, a style of much warmth of quality, which reaches lovely softness in the treatment of clouds. In fact the quality of etching is all but eliminated by the mechanics of this method. Whatever may be said of etchers who go beyond usual lengths to get new effects, Senseney has developed a kind of art that is pleasing decoration. His trees are done in a mass color effect as in the "Bend of the River" against a bright background and full-clouded sky. The European series shows some interesting studies of architecture, of which the "Devout Woman," depicting a worshipper in a wayside chapel, carries a note of human interest.

A mosaic interior for the marble memorial mausoleum being erected in Hollywood Cemetery, Los Angeles, by William A. Clark Jr. is being exhibited at the studios of J. & R. Lamb in lower Sixth Avenue. The work is the conception of the Lamb studios and will be in eight panels, three on either side of the edifice, with one at each end. The color motive is deep blue with varicolored border design and in the side panels figures symbolizing man's contributions to human development. The main end panel depicts a religious group, consisting of the Mother and Child and the Angel of Annunciation, while above them is placed a resplendent cross in mother of pearl. The wall design rears itself overhead into a dome of blue studded with gold stars, the whole plan being in Byzantine motive. It is set up here for temporary exhibition, but illustrates well a type of architectural art which was carried to great lengths of beauty by the artisans of the Near East.

From now until May 15 the Whitney Studio Club will house an exhibition of modern painting by Stuart Davis and J. Torres-Garcia, together with sculpture by Stanislaw Szukalski. It is all in the same key. Garcia has come over from Spain with an ambition, like his illustrious countryman in myth, to conquer not merely a windmill but a whole city at a blow. He has made a picture of New York City on a yard of canvas, but descends from this detached point of view to paint some still life studies of fruit. His co-exhibitor is equally unconventional in his manner of painting. Mr. Davis's still life conceptions of various popular brands of cigarettes are novel. There is a certain feeling of symmetry in the sculpture of Szukalski, to which such titles as "Che Yo Power" and "Tigore Power" have been given.
