

Playfellow Finishes Last in Field of Three in Fair Play Handicap at the Aqueduct Track

Fair Gain Beats \$115,000 Colt In Race at Mile

Thunderstorm Noses Out Brother of Man of War; Several Favorites Lose

Playfellow, the full brother of Man of War, ran last in a field of three in a handicap named after his daddy at the Aqueduct track yesterday afternoon. But in defeat this son of Fair Play-Manuhub proved himself a mighty fine thoroughbred, for he tried to give away over the mile route as much as twenty-four pounds to older horses that went to the post about as fit as hands could make them.

This Fair Play Handicap was won by Joseph E. Widener's Fair Gain, a four-year-old chestnut colt which by the scale carried only 102 pounds to Playfellow's 114. Charles Koehler's five-year-old chestnut horse Thunderstorm, which was the one figured to give Man of War's little brother a fight (if fight he had) totaled 106 pounds on his back. Thunderstorm did not approximate the form expected of him and barely managed to nose out Playfellow for second money. Fair Gain was only a length in front of the other two at the end.

While this race was not the feature of the card, it probably commanded more interest than any other because of the speculation as to whether or not Playfellow could fulfill a task that would have been a credit to Man of War, and which his illustrious brother never attempted, as the three-year-old sensation of last year never went against older handicap horses until he met Sir Barton in the match race at Windsor.

Should Not Be Condemned Playfellow should not be condemned on yesterday's race. He proved a much better colt than many handicappers figured him, though probably nowhere near the class of his illustrious brother and several pounds shy his great stable mate, Grey Lag, too. There were those who thought Earl Sande made too much use of Playfellow at the start, though possibly Sande followed stable instructions. Certainly there was no occasion, in the defeat of this odds-on favorite, for the hisses of several niggers who greeted Sande when he returned to weigh out.

Sande rushed Playfellow to the front soon after the start and opened up a lead of more than two lengths around the turn. Fair Gain hung most closely to the pace, and when the weight began to tell on Playfellow half way down the stretch took command and came away to a good lead. But Fair Gain, in turn, began to show signs of distress a sixteenth from home and had to be ridden hard by McAttee.

Thunderstorm, on the other hand, lay too far off the pace, and though he closed fast through the final furlong and nosed Playfellow out of the place he never had a chance to overcome Fair Gain's lead. Playfellow, by the way, hung on gamely under punishment through the last quarter.

Budana First in Stakes Though the Rancocas Stable was disappointed in the performance of its new \$115,000 investment, there was occasion for joy in the running of the clover stakes, at five furlongs, for two-year-old fillies. Sande got home in front with Budana, a Zeis filly which Sam Hildreth bought as a yearling at the Saratoga sales.

Budana got away winging and set the pace all the way, but was done her best to stand off Harry Payne Whitney's Penitent at the finish. This was one of the best betting races of a long time, for it was one of the most open juvenile events that could be imagined. Lucky Button, which finished third; Nancy F., Mission Bella and Flying Jib were almost equally favored, while there was also a heavy play on Valencia.

The players were hit with a truckload of dynamite. The program was
