By Collyer to the Putney... LONDON, April 1. In a biting wind and rough water, Cambridge won the varsity boat race over the Putney to Mortlake course on the Thames, by four and a half lengths today.

The Light Blue crew, with every advantage of weight and training in its favor, was further aided by winning the toss for the position, which in weather like this centered heavily on the first half of the race.

After a false start the shells got under way at 11:42, Oxford rowing a 23 stroke and Cambridge 25. The Light Blues took the lead immediately and were a quarter length ahead as the boat-houses were passed.

Here, Oxford made a spurt and during the next minute managed to keep the bow of its shell an eighth of a length ahead.

At the halfway point was reached the Cambridge had dropped to 37, while Oxford stroke had increased to 37. From this point to Barnes Bridge the heavier Cambridge crew continued to forge ahead and boomed under the bridge with a lead of two lengths.

It was here that the Oxford oarsmen began to lag noticeably, with the result that Cambridge went on to the finish to win handsily.

Fifty members of the Oxford eight were in a state of collapse at the finish, while only one Cambridge man was in a state of complete exhaustion.
